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## PREFACE

This publication has been produced in response to a demand for more comprehensive statistical information about families with children, particularly for small areas of the State. The data have been obtained from the 1981 Census of Population and Housing and provide details of the composition and characteristics of all families who were enumerated in private dwellings in New South Wales at 30 June 1981, and who had one or more children under 16 years.

The first twelve tables present general information about N.S.W. families, and include cross-classified characteristics of both two-parent and single-parent families. They are followed by four tables which provide selected family characteristics for local government areas and statistical areas (i.e. statistical divisions, subdivisions and districts).

Before studying the tables in this publication, readers are urged to read the Explanatory Notes carefully, particularly notes 2, 3 and 15 which explain some of the limitations of the data, and notes 6 and 7 which deal with the scope of the collection.

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

### INTRODUCTION

The information in this publication has been obtained from the 1981 Census of Population and Housing and shows selected characteristics of families with children under 16 years for New South Wales as a whole, and for local government areas and statistical areas. The tables show two-parent and single-parent families separately.

2. Because the census obtains information about the population at a point of time, it has some limitations when used to analyse family situations. The data obtained reflects the situation existing on census night which may have been different to the "usual" situation of the family. Also, as there was no direct question on the 1981 Census schedule (or at any previous census) which asked whether a person was a "single" parent, it has been necessary to derive information on these families indirectly from the combined responses to several of the census questions. For these and other reasons (see also notes 10 and 15), these families have been referred to in the tables as apparent single-parent families.

3. The statistics contained in this publication cannot therefore be taken as precise measures of two-parent and single-parent families, but should be considered as indicators only, and, particularly for small cells, interpreted with caution. For this reason and also because of conceptual differences, the family data in this publication are not strictly comparable with family data obtained from ABS surveys or other sources.

### SCOPE AND COVERAGE OF THE CENSUS

4. The 1981 Census of Population and Housing aimed at counting every person who spent census night, 30 June 1981, in Australia, including persons on vessels in or between Australian ports, or on board long-distance trains, buses or aircraft. All dwellings were counted, whether occupied or unoccupied. People were counted where they were on census night, which may not be where they usually lived. Visitors to Australia were enumerated regardless of how long ago they had arrived or

how long they planned to stay. Australian residents out of the country on census night were excluded from the count.

5. While every effort is made to minimise under-counting in the census, some inevitably remains for various reasons (e.g. inadvertent omission of very young children, treatment of some dwellings as unoccupied when, in fact, they were occupied, and failure to find all dwellings). Refusal by householders to complete the census schedule is not a significant cause of under-counting.

### SCOPE OF THESE STATISTICS

6. For census purposes family relationships are coded only for persons in private dwellings, and family relationships for occupants of non-private dwellings (e.g. hotels, motels, boarding houses, caravan parks, etc.) are therefore excluded from the tables.

7. The populations used in compiling the statistics for this publication were: -

- i. Two-parent families - all family units containing one or more children under 16 years, with a family head aged 16 years or more, and spouse, both present on census night.
- ii. Single-parent families - all family units containing one or more children under 16 years, with a family head aged 16 years or more, and with no spouse present on census night.

### FAMILY STRUCTURE

8. The determination of family relationships and composition is complex, and a strict set of rules was followed in processing these characteristics. The basis of all family coding at the 1981 Census was Question 4 on the census schedule which asked "What is each persons relationship to Person 1?". If the relationship was not stated, the family structure was imputed from the replies to questions 1, 2, 3, 5, 6 and 8. Responses to other questions, such as total issue (number of children born to a female and now living), and usual residence one and five years ago, may also have been consulted. Questions 1 to 6, and 8 are reproduced on the following page.

**9. Families are defined on the basis of blood and marriage (including "defacto") relationships, and are largely based on the nuclear (immediate) family.**

**10. Family data relates only to persons enumerated in private dwellings, and usual family members not present in the dwelling on census night are counted at their actual location and assessed in terms of family status at that location (if a private**

dwelling). Thus a number of single-parent families may be recorded as such merely because a spouse was temporarily absent on census night, and two-parent and single-parent families with all children under 16 years absent from home on census night would be omitted from the tables. Children away from home (e.g. in boarding school, in hospital, or on holidays without the rest of the family) will also have some effect on the family size figures.

11. An information paper: Census 81 - Dwelling, Household, Family (2150.0) provides detailed information about the treatment of family units, and is available on application.

## DEFINITIONS

12. Families and Family Heads: So that family units can be identified for census purposes, a head is designated for every household. (A household is defined as a person or group of persons living together as a domestic unit with common eating arrangements). The household head is the designated head of the primary family unit (see below). If there are no other household members, the household head, by definition, comprises a one-person household and a one-person family. If there are other household members present on census night, the relationships to household head given in answer to Question 4 (and in some cases other information on the schedule) is used to allocate them to the primary family unit, to one or more secondary family units, or to non-family members.

Secondary family units must consist of at least two persons, one of whom is the designated family head. In the rare cases where there were more than one primary and three secondary families, the additional persons were treated as non-family members.

13. Children: All children under 16 years who were in the household on census night were included in either the primary or secondary family units described above. Thus, visiting children who were not usual members of the family, would have been included with the family with which they were staying on census night. Indications are that the inclusion of these children does not have any significant effect on the family size data. Figures for N.S.W. as a whole show that only about one percent of all children enumerated in occupied private dwellings on census night were visiting children.

It should be noted that the terms "children" and "family size" used in this publication refer only to children aged under 16 years. Older children in these families have been omitted from all tables.

14. Dependants: The term "dependants" used in tables 1 and 13 refers to children aged 16 - 20 years who were living with the family on census night, and were still attending full-time at an educational institution.

15. Marital Status: The term "two-parent families" includes all couples who were together on census night and who indicated that they were married, or identified their living arrangements as "defacto" or "living together as married". It should be noted that some respondents may have chosen not to reveal that they were "living together as married" and therefore the number of couples living in this situation may be understated with a corresponding overstatement of the number of single-parent families.

"Single-parent families" are those with a head but no spouse present on census night. It is likely that many of these family heads were persons whose spouse was only temporarily absent on census night (see also note 10). To facilitate the study of single-parent families, data for families with married heads have been shown separately in each table which provides information about single-parent families.

The term "not now married" used in this publication refers to family heads whose marital status was given as "never married", "widowed", "divorced" or "separated". It should be noted that this latter category includes heads who were still legally married at census date, but were separated (legally or otherwise) from their spouse.

16. Family Income: At the 1981 Census each person aged 15 years or more was asked to indicate their gross income from all sources, including wages, salary, overtime, pensions, allowances, benefits, investments, etc.

Family income is defined as the sum of the individual incomes of the head of a family and spouse, where both were present on census night, or the individual income of the head where no spouse was present. When studying family income it should be kept in mind that persons were enumerated where they spent census night and not where they usually lived. Thus, where a family which usually comprised a head and spouse had one parent absent from

home for any reason on census night, the family will be included in these tables as a single-parent family and the family income will reflect only the income (if any) of the parent who was at home.

It should be noted that some persons are classified as "employed" even though they indicated that they had no income. (e.g. persons who worked without pay for 15 hours or more in the week prior to the census in a family business). Census figures for N.S.W. as a whole show that in 1981 about 1.6 percent of employed persons reported no income.

17. Dwelling structure: The classification of private dwelling structure is based on replies supplied by the collectors through external observation of the structure type. At the 1981 Census all dwellings were allocated to one of the following eight structure types :

- a. Separate House - A separate house is a single dwelling usually separated by open space from other dwellings. However, included in this category are flats attached to a house or in a converted garage.
- b. Semi-detached House - Two houses joined together, single or multi-storey, usually separated by open space from other dwellings. This category is for the OLDER style of Semi-detached house.
- c. Row or Terrace House - Three or more houses joined together in a row (single or multi-storey). This category is for the OLDER style of Row or Terrace house.
- d. Medium Density Housing - This category includes all medium density housing developments - Villa homes, Town houses, blocks of flats or home units up to and including 3 storeys high. Also included are any Separate houses, Semi-detached houses and Row or Terrace houses CONVERTED INTO TWO OR MORE FLATS.
- e. Flats Over Three Storeys - Blocks of flats or home units over 3 storeys high.
- f. Caravan, Houseboat, etc - Mobile units occupied on a permanent or semi-permanent basis.
- g. Improvised Home - Shed, tent, etc.

occupied on a permanent or semi-permanent basis.

- h. House or Flat attached to a Shop, Office, etc - A house or flat attached to a shop, office, factory or any other non-residential structure.

In this publication types f, g and h above have been included in the category "Other and not stated".

18. Nature of occupancy: This indicates whether the dwelling is owned (subject to mortgage or otherwise), or rented, either from the State Housing Commission or other agency.

19. Labour force status: The labour force status of family heads has been shown in three categories -

- a. Employed, that is
  - i. persons who worked for wages, salary, payment or profit during the week prior to census night, or helped without pay in a family business for 15 hours or more; or
  - ii. had a job from which they were temporarily absent because they were on recreation leave, sick, on strike, temporarily stood down, etc., during the week prior to census night.
- b. Unemployed, that is did not work and did not have a job, but were actively looking for work during the week prior to census night.
- c. Not in the labour force, that is persons who in the week prior to census night were neither "employed" or "unemployed" as defined above. They include persons who were keeping house (unpaid), attending an educational institution, retired, voluntarily inactive, permanently unable to work, etc.

#### INTRODUCED RANDOM ERROR

20. In order to ensure that information relating to an identifiable person is not released, it has been necessary for the ABS to randomly adjust non-zero cells in the more

detailed census tabulations released as publications, microfiche or magnetic tape (including those contained in this publication). This process allows the maximum amount of detailed census data to be released while avoiding the risk of inadvertently releasing information identifiable as relating to a particular person or household. The adjustment process slightly changes some of the data in the tables in an unbiased way. Because non-zero cells including totals have been randomly adjusted, the totals shown may be slightly greater or less than the sum of their components.

In effect this process means that:

little reliance should be placed on small cells. (Even without random adjustment, care should be exercised in interpreting small cells since this is where any response or processing errors would be likely to have greatest impact), and

caution should be exercised in stating that there were no persons having certain characteristics, as some small cells have been randomly altered to zero.

The percentages shown in this publication have been calculated from the original (unrandomised) figures and have not been randomly adjusted. However, if a user wishes to calculate proportions, percentages or ratios, based on any of the figures in this publication, the random error introduced can be ignored, except when very small cells are involved.

21. Further information on the introduced random error is contained in the information paper: Census 81 - Effects of Introduced Random Error (2156.0).

#### GEOGRAPHIC DEFINITIONS

22. Local Government Areas in New South Wales are constituted under the Local Government Act, 1919, and comprise municipalities (usually centres of population) and shires (for the most part country areas embracing tracts of rural land as well as towns and villages). Twenty-nine municipalities had been proclaimed as cities as at 30 June 1981.

#### 23. Statistical areas of New South Wales

For the purpose of presenting the principal series of official statistics for the State, New South Wales is divided into a number of geographic areas. These areas consist, for the most part, of aggregations of local government areas.

The primary division of the State is into 12 statistical divisions. These are intended to represent "regions" of the State which are characterised by discernible social and/or economic links between the inhabitants and economic units within them, under the unifying influence of one or more major cities or towns. The boundaries of the divisions have accordingly been delineated on the basic criterion that the degree of economic and/or social contact and interaction within each division should be maximised. It should be emphasised that the boundaries of the divisions cannot be regarded as sharp lines of demarcation - they may, of necessity, be positioned within peripheral zones in which the influence of two or more "focal" cities or towns overlap in varying degrees.

In the case of Sydney and its periphery, the factors taken into account in drawing the divisional boundary are necessarily different from those for the rest of the State. The Sydney Statistical Division is predominantly urban in character - and its boundary was re-delineated in 1976 to embrace the area expected to contain the urban development of Sydney (and associated smaller urban centres) for a period of at least twenty years. This area covers the same area as the "Sydney Region", as delineated by the State Planning Authority (now the N.S.W. Department of Environment and Planning) in its publication Sydney Region, 1970-2000 A.D., Outline Plan.

The statistical divisions are subdivided to provide a second tier of statistical areas comprising statistical districts and statistical subdivisions.

Statistical districts are areas which encompass an urban centre with a population of 25,000 or more and which are predominantly urban in character. They have been delineated using concepts and criteria similar to those for the Sydney Statistical Division.

Statistical subdivisions within Sydney Statistical Division were delineated in 1976, in order to provide statistical areas of optimum assistance to users (particularly physical and social planners). The boundaries of the seven subdivisions created within Sydney Statistical Division have been drawn to coincide with the regions formed by the former Department of Urban and Regional Development. Statistical subdivisions outside Sydney Statistical Division are component areas within statistical divisions which have been delineated broadly on the basis of topographical and/or climatic features and reflect, *inter alia*, some degree of homogeneity of agricultural activity.



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## SUMMARY OF FINDINGS


At the 1981 Census of Population and Housing there were 1,717,739 families of various types enumerated in private dwellings in New South Wales. Of these, 669,236 (39.0 per cent) had one or more children aged under 16 years. Almost 1 in 6 of all families with children under 16 years had only one parent present on Census night. These families are referred to throughout this publication as "apparent single-parent families". (See Explanatory Notes 2, 10 and 15).

The following graph shows the age distribution and marital status of the heads of the 104,989 apparent single-parent families.


About seven out of every eight apparent single-parent family heads were females. Sixteen per cent of apparent single-parent family heads indicated that their marital status was "married", and it is probable that in many of these families the spouse was only temporarily absent on Census night (perhaps because of his/her occupation). This view is supported by an examination of the various family characteristics tabulated in this publication, which shows that in each case the characteristics of the apparent single-parent families with married heads are similar to the characteristics of two-parent families, and differ markedly from the single-parent families where the family head was "not now married" (i.e. never married, widowed, divorced or separated). Accordingly, in the following analyses of family characteristics, (except for the sections on "Children with working parents", and "Distribution of families in the Sydney Statistical Division"), the data on apparent single-parent families relates only to the 88,164 families where the family head was "not now married".

#### Income

There is a marked difference in the income distribution patterns of two-parent and apparent single-parent families. Almost 70 per cent of two-parent families had an annual family income exceeding \$12,000, with the largest single group being in the \$26,001 and over range.

The figures for apparent single-parent families on the other hand show that only 14.0 per cent had annual family incomes exceeding \$12,000, while over 40 per cent had family incomes in the \$4,001 - \$6,000 range (compared with only 1.4 per cent of two-parent families). From these latter figures it appears that many of the apparent single-parent families had incomes derived mainly or solely from the supporting parents benefits paid by the Federal Government. At 30 June 1981, subject to eligibility, the supporting parent's benefit was \$74.15 per week (\$3,855 per year), plus an allowance of \$10 per week (\$520 per year) for each dependent child. A supporting parent was also eligible for an allowance of up to \$6 per week (\$312 per year), or \$8 per week (\$416 per year) where there was an invalid child or a child under 6 years of age. These benefits would place most recipients (assuming that they had no other significant sources of income) in the \$4,001 - \$6,000 income range.


DIAGRAM 3. FAMILY INCOMES, N.S.W., 30 JUNE 1981



#### Labour force status of parents

Of the 564,246 two-parent families with children under 16 years, 95.4 per cent of male parents, and 47.0 per cent of female parents were in the labour force (see Explanatory Note 19). In 46 per cent of these families both parents were in the labour force. In apparent single-parent families, 83.3 per cent of male heads were in the labour force, while only 36.8 per cent of female heads were in the labour force.

#### Children with working parents


There were 1,307,728 children under 16 years living with their parents (or parent) in private dwellings in New South Wales at the Census of 30 June 1981. Of these, 505,965 were in two-parent families with both parents in the labour force, and 73,479 were in apparent single-parent families with the family head in the labour force. For children under 5 years, 32.5 per cent lived with families where both parents (or the apparent single-parent) were in the labour force. The percentage increased for older children, reaching 53.7 per cent for those in the 13-15 age group. Overall, 44.3 per cent of all children under 16 years belonged to families with both parents (or the apparent single-parent) in the labour force. The following table summarises this data. (See also Tables 6 and 8).

Family size (number of children aged under 16 years)

Two-parent families averaged 2.0 children under 16 years per family, while apparent single-parent families averaged only 1.7 children. About one third of all two-parent families had only one child under 16 years, but more than one half of all apparent single-parent families had only one child in this age range.




Family dwelling: Type of structure

On Census night, 30 June 1981, 87.4 per cent of two-parent families were living in separate houses, 9.1 per cent in medium-density housing (defined for the purposes of this analysis as semi-detached houses, row or terrace houses, flats up to 3 storeys, etc.), and 0.7 per cent in flats of more than 3 storeys.

By comparison, only 70.4 per cent of apparent single-parent families were living in separate houses, 24.1 per cent were in medium-density housing, and 2.2 per cent in flats of more than 3 storeys.


DIAGRAM 6. FAMILY DWELLING : TYPE OF DWELLING STRUCTURE, N.S.W., 30 JUNE 1981



#### Family dwelling: Nature of occupancy

The basis on which families occupied their dwellings also showed considerable differences. 73.9 per cent of two-parent families owned or were purchasing the dwelling they were occupying on census night, compared with only 44.1 per cent of apparent single-parent families. 18.4 per cent of apparent single-parent families rented a Housing Commission dwelling, and 32.5 per cent rented dwellings from other landlords. The corresponding figures for two-parent families were 5.1 per cent and 15.7 per cent respectively. The following diagram shows nature of occupancy for both types of families with apparent single-parent family heads shown by marital status. Widowed family heads show the highest proportion of home ownership (although still significantly lower than the figure for two-parent families), and never married family heads show the lowest proportion.

#### Distribution of families in the Sydney Statistical Division

The computer-drawn maps on the following pages (Diagrams 8,9, and 10) show local government areas in the Sydney Statistical Division grouped according to the proportions of families with children under 16 years, and the numbers and proportions of apparent single-parent families. Maps showing similar detail for areas outside the Sydney Statistical Division have not been included because of the difficulty of presenting them in this form, but the relevant data for all local government areas and other statistical areas can be found in Table 13.

The percentage groups shown in Diagrams 8 and 9 were derived by listing the local government areas in descending order, according to their percentage, and then dividing them into five groupings of approximately the same size. The map key shows the percentage ranges in each group, with the figures in brackets indicating the number of local government areas involved. The third map (Diagram 10) which shows numbers instead of percentages has been prepared using simple groupings of "Under 1,000", "1,000 - 1,999", etc. of families. Again, the number of local government areas in each grouping is shown in brackets in the map key.

Diagram 8 shows families with children under 16 years as a percentage of total families in each local government area. The local government areas with the highest percentages were in the outer areas of Sydney, the highest being in the City of Campbelltown with 64.3 per cent. The lowest percentages were found in the inner areas with the City of Sydney and North Sydney Municipality having percentages of only 11.2 and 12.4 respectively.

Diagram 9 shows apparent single-parent families with children under 16 years as a percentage of all families with children under 16 years in each local government area. The local government areas with the highest percentages are all clustered in the inner areas. The highest percentage was found in the City of Sydney with 31.5 per cent, with the lowest percentage being in Baulkham Hills Shire with 8.5 per cent. The figure for the Sydney Statistical Division as a whole was 15.7 per cent.


The picture of apparent single-parent families changes considerably when numbers, rather than percentages, are considered. Diagram 10 shows the number of such families in five groupings of local government areas. Most of the inner local government areas did not have high numbers. The highest number (by a considerable margin) was the 5,261 apparent single-parent families enumerated in the City of Blacktown. The City of Campbelltown and the Shire of Warringah both had in excess of 3,000, with the local government areas of Bankstown, Canterbury, Fairfield, Liverpool, Parramatta, Penrith, Randwick and Sutherland having between 2,000 and 3,000.






