NOTE. - Details of Stated Purpose of Travel of Visitors Arriving long-term and Residents Departing long-term may be found in the notes at the foot of Table 7 (Visitors) and Table 10 (Residents).

For figures of Australian Residents departing in the long-term movement, classified according to the country in which they intend to stay for twelve months or more, and of Visitors arriving long-term, classified by country of last residence - see "Oversea Arrivals and Departures, Part 1."

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Oversea travellers are classified for statistical purposes into permanent, long-term and short-term movements. The basis of the classification is explained below.

2. This publication provides, in Section I, detailed statistics of total oversea arrivals and departures and, in Section II, detailed statistics of oversea arrivals and departures in the short-term movement, in the June quarter, 1965. Detailed statistics of the arrivals and departures in the permanent and long-term movement in the same quarter have appeared in the companion publication "Oversea Arrivals and Departures - Part 1 - Permanent and Long-term Movement" issued on 13th September, 1965. Preliminary monthly figures of oversea arrivals and departures, classified into permanent, long-term and short-term movements, are also issued, the latest being in respect of August, 1965 (see "Oversea Arrivals and Departures - August, 1965 (Preliminary)", issued on 23rd September, 1965).

3. Table 1 of this publication contains statistics, since 1946, of oversea travellers classified into permanent and long-term movement on the one hand and short-term movement on the other, the latter being divided into movements of Australian residents and oversea visitors. From 1959 the permanent and long-term movement was divided into permanent movement (settlers arriving and Australian residents departing permanently) and long-term movement, the latter being further divided into long-term movements of Australian residents and oversea visitors. Information in accordance with the extended categories is shown in Table 2 of this publication. The remaining tables in Section I contain further statistics of total movement in the June quarter, 1965.

4. Statistics classifying total movement according to country of birth and according to age, conjugal condition and sex are prepared for six monthly periods only. Details for the half-year ended June, 1965 are shown in Section III of this publication.

5. The classification into permanent, long-term and short-term is based on the purpose of travel stated by the traveller on arrival in, or departure from, Australia. THESE STATEMENTS REPRESENT THE TRAVELLER'S INTENTION AT THE TIME. MANY TRAVELLERS SUBSEQUENTLY CHANGE THEIR INTENTIONS AND THIS MUST BE BORNE IN MIND IN INTERPRETING THE STATISTICS.

6. Permanent movement consists of persons arriving with stated intent to settle permanently in Australia, and Australian residents departing with stated intent to reside permanently abroad. Settlers are persons who, on arrival in Australia, indicated that they came intending to settle. Former Settlers are persons who, on departure from Australia, stated that they had come to Australia intending to settle, had stayed for a period of twelve months or more and were now departing permanently. Persons who stated a period of less than twelve months are classified to "visitors departing, short-term movement".

7. Long-term movement consists of the arrival of visitors and the departure of residents with stated intent to stay (in Australia or in a country abroad, respectively) for twelve months or more, and the departure of visitors and the return of Australians who have stayed (in Australia or in a country abroad, respectively) for twelve months or more.

8. Short-term movement consists of all other movements, including the movement of Australian troops irrespective of period of stay. Visitors arriving and residents departing are further classified according to stated purpose of travel, the categories being, for visitors, "In transit", "Business", "Holiday", "Education" and "Other purposes", and for residents, "Business", "Holiday", "Education" and "Other purposes". "In transit" visitors include all who state "In transit" as their purpose of journey to Australia provided that their intended length of stay in Australia does not exceed one month. However, the statistics do not include persons passing through Australia without change of ship or aircraft. These passengers are not included in Australian statistics of arrivals or departures. Persons on a short pleasure cruise commencing and finishing in Australia on a ship not engaged in a regular voyage, and air crew and ships' crew are also excluded.
