


TREND ESTIMATES

EMPLOYMENT

- continues to increase and is now 2.7% higher than the January 1993 low point

UNEMPLOYMENT RATE

- has fallen in each of the last five months
- for males, the rate is one percentage point lower than the December 1992/January 1993 peak of 11.1%. For females, the rate stands at 10.0%, having fallen from a peak of 10.4% in September 1993

PARTICIPATION RATE

- stood at 63.0% for the third successive month, representing the highest level recorded since June 1991

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED ESTIMATES

EMPLOYMENT

- full-time employment rose by 39,800 to 5,960,300 with an increase of 38,700 in female full-time employment. Part-time employment fell by 25,300 to 1,859,400

UNEMPLOYMENT

- fell to 913,900, the lowest level recorded since May 1992


UNEMPLOYMENT RATE

- unchanged at 10.5%. For males, the rate rose slightly to 10.9%; for females, the rate fell by 0.2 percentage points to 9.9%
- NSW 10.0% (10.4% last month); Vic. 11.8% (11.8%); Qld 9.9% (10.1%); SA 10.7% (11.2%); WA 8.9% (9.0%); Tas. 12.0% (11.7%)



PRINCIPAL LABOUR FORCE SERIES: Trend estimates


EMPLOYED PERSONS

After falling generally between June 1990 and January 1993, the trend in employment has been increasing since then and stood at 7,821,500 in February 1994. The February 1994 estimate was 0.9% lower than the June 1990 peak.




UNEMPLOYED PERSONS

Trend estimates of unemployment rose from a low of 492,000 in October 1989 to 950,000 in November 1992. Apart from a four month rise in mid 1993, the trend has been decreasing since November 1992 and now stands at 917,800, the lowest since April 1992.



UNEMPLOYMENT RATE

The trend unemployment rate has been falling since September 1993 and stood at 10.5% in February 1994, compared with the peak of 11.1% recorded in October to December 1992.




STATES: Trend estimates

UNEMPLOYMENT RATE


NEW SOUTH WALES

For NSW, the trend unemployment rate has been falling generally since February 1993 and now stands at 10.2%, compared with 5.9% in October and November 1989.




VICTORIA

From a low of 4.7% between July 1989 and February 1990, the trend unemployment rate for Victoria increased to a peak of 12.5% in August and September 1993. Since then, the rate has fallen and now stands at 11.8%.



QUEENSLAND

The trend unemployment rate in Queensland reached a peak of 10.8% in November and December 1992 and again in August to October 1993. Since then, the rate has fallen and stood at 10.0% in February 1994.



UNEMPLOYMENT RATE


SOUTH AUSTRALIA

The trend unemployment rate increased from 6.9% in September to November 1989 to a peak of 12.0% in June 1992. It then fell to 10.6% in July 1993 before rising again. The rate has stood at 11.1% in the last three months.




WESTERN AUSTRALIA

For Western Australia, the trend unemployment rate increased from a low point of 5.6% in April and May 1989 to a peak of 11.1% in December 1992 to February 1993. This level was reached again in September 1993. Since then, the rate has fallen and stood at 9.0% in February 1994.



TASMANIA

After increasing from 8.5% in March 1990 to a peak of 12.9% in August 1993, the trend unemployment rate for Tasmania has fallen in each of the last six months to 11.8% in February 1994.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

INTRODUCTION

1 This publication contains preliminary estimates of the civilian labour force derived from the labour force survey component of the monthly population survey. Estimates for the current month are preliminary and subject to revision. Revised estimates for the current month and more detailed estimates will be published in *The Labour Force, Australia* (6203.0).

MONTHLY POPULATION SURVEY

2 The population survey is based on a multi-stage area sample of private dwellings (currently about 29,000 houses, flats, etc.) and a list sample of non-private dwellings (hotels, motels, etc.), and covers about 0.5% of the population of Australia. The information is obtained from the occupants of selected dwellings by specially trained interviewers. The interviews are generally conducted during the two weeks beginning on the Monday between the 6th and 12th of each month. The information obtained relates to the week before the interview (i.e. the reference week).

SCOPE OF SURVEY

3 The Labour Force Survey includes all persons aged 15 and over except members of the permanent defence forces, certain diplomatic personnel of overseas governments customarily excluded from census and estimated populations, overseas residents in Australia, and members of non-Australian defence forces (and their dependants) stationed in Australia.

COVERAGE

4 In the Labour Force Survey, coverage rules are applied which aim to ensure that each person is associated with only one dwelling, and hence has only one chance of selection. The coverage rules are necessarily a balance between theoretical and operational considerations. Nevertheless, the chance of a person being enumerated at two separate dwellings in the survey is considered to be negligible.

POPULATION BENCHMARKS

5 Labour Force Survey estimates are calculated in such a way as to add up to independent estimates of the civilian population aged 15 and over (population benchmarks). From February 1994, labour force estimates have been compiled using benchmarks based on the results of the 1991 Census of Population and Housing. Small revisions have been made to many of the historical estimates from January 1989 to January 1994.

REVISION OF SERIES

6 From April 1986, the definition of employed persons was changed to include persons who worked without pay between 1 and 14 hours per week in a family business or on a farm (i.e. unpaid family helpers). For further information, see paragraphs 36 and 37 of the Explanatory Notes to the February 1987 issue of *The Labour Force, Australia* (6203.0).

SURVEY SAMPLE REDESIGN

7 The Labour Force Survey sample has been redesigned and reselected using information collected in the 1991 Census of Population and Housing. The new sample was phased in over the period September to December 1992. For details, see *Information Paper: Labour Force Survey Sample Design* (6269.0).

8 For the most part, one quarter of the new sample was introduced each month so that, by December 1992, the entire new sample was in place. Replacement generally occurred at the rotation group level with two groups being substituted each month. Such a pattern of implementation meant that any changes to labour force estimates due to differences between the two samples, or any other influences, were spread over the four months rather than being concentrated in one inter-month period.

9 This phase-in scheme applied to the private dwelling sample in urban areas. The new sample for non-private dwellings and private dwellings in rural areas was introduced in a single stage in November 1992.

RELIABILITY OF ESTIMATES

10 Two types of error are possible in an estimate based on a sample survey: sampling error and non-sampling error.

Sampling error occurs because a sample, rather than the entire population, is surveyed. One measure of the likely difference resulting from not including all dwellings in the survey is given by the standard error. There are about two chances in three that a sample estimate will differ by less than one standard error from the figure that would have been obtained if all dwellings had been included in the survey, and about nineteen chances in twenty that the difference will be less than two standard errors. Standard errors of estimates for the latest month and of estimates of movements since the previous month are shown on pages 30 and 31. Standard errors of other estimates and other movements may be determined by using information in the Technical Note in *The Labour Force, Australia* (6203.0).

Non sampling error arises from inaccuracies in collecting, recording and processing the data. Every effort is made to minimise reporting error by the careful design of questionnaires, intensive training and supervision of interviewers, and efficient data processing procedures.

SEASONAL ADJUSTMENT AND
TREND ESTIMATION

11 Seasonally adjusted series are published in Tables 2, 5 and 12 to 17. Seasonal factors are reviewed annually to take account of each additional year's original data. The results of the latest review were used to compile the revised seasonally adjusted and trend estimates given in this publication. Information about the method of adjustment and revised seasonally adjusted and trend estimates for all months from January 1988 will be published in an appendix to the February 1994 issue of *The Labour Force, Australia* (6203.0) to be released at the end of March 1994.

12 Seasonal adjustment is a means of removing the estimated effects of normal seasonal variation from the series so that the effects of other influences on the series can be more clearly recognised. Seasonal adjustment does not aim to remove the irregular or non-seasonal influences which may be present in any particular month. This means that month-to-month movements of the seasonally adjusted estimates may not be reliable indicators of trend behaviour. For example, irregular factors unrelated to the trend account for more than half the seasonally adjusted movement with the following frequency:

- Employment: 5 in 10 monthly movements
- Unemployment: 7 in 10 monthly movements
- Unemployment rate: 7 in 10 monthly movements
- Participation rate: 9 in 10 monthly movements

13 Smoothing seasonally adjusted series produces a measure of trend by reducing the impact of the irregular component of the series. The trend estimates have been derived by applying a 13-term Henderson-weighted moving average to the series. Trend series are used to analyse the underlying behaviour of the series over time. These are published in Tables 3, 6 and 12 to 19.

14 While this smoothing technique enables estimates to be produced for the latest month, it does result in revisions to the most recent months as additional observations become available. Generally, subsequent revisions become smaller, and after three months have a negligible impact on the series. There will also be revisions as a result of the annual review of seasonal factors.

SEASONAL ADJUSTMENT AND TREND ESTIMATION (continued)	<p>15 Trend estimates are published for the Northern Territory in Table 18 and for the Australian Capital Territory in Table 19. Unadjusted series for the two Territories have shown, historically, a high degree of variability, which can lead to considerable revisions to the seasonally adjusted estimates after each annual seasonal factor re-analysis. Seasonally adjusted estimates are not currently published for the two Territories. The most recent six months trend estimates are subject to revision. For the three most recent months, the revision may be relatively large. Inferences about trends drawn from smoothed seasonally adjusted (trend) estimates for months earlier than the latest three months are unlikely to be affected by month to month revisions. Actively looking for work	Includes writing, telephoning or applying in person to an employer for work; answering a newspaper advertisement for a job; checking factory or Commonwealth Employment Service noticeboards; being registered with the Commonwealth Employment Service; checking or registering with any other employment agency; advertising or tendering for work; and contacting friends or relatives.
Attending school	Persons aged 15 to 19 enrolled full time at secondary or high schools in the reference week.
Attending tertiary educational institution full time	Persons aged 15 to 24 enrolled full time at a TAFE college, university, or other educational institution in the reference week.

Part-time workers	Employed persons who usually worked less than 35 hours a week and who did so during the reference week.
Seasonally adjusted series	A time series of estimates with the estimated effects of normal seasonal variation removed. See Explanatory Note 11 to 12 for more detail.
Trend series	A smoothed seasonally adjusted series of estimates. See Explanatory Notes 13 to 15 for more detail.

STANDARD ERRORS

The estimates in this publication are based on information gained from the occupants of a sample survey of dwellings. Because the entire population is not surveyed, the published estimates are subject to sampling error. The most common way of quantifying such sampling error is to calculate the standard error for the published estimate or statistic.

LEVEL ESTIMATES

To illustrate, let us say the published level estimate for employed persons aged 15 to 19 is 500,000. The calculated standard error in this case is 9,000. The standard error is then used to interpret the level estimate of 500,000. For instance, the standard error of 9,000 indicates that:

- * There are approximately two chances in three that the real value falls within the range 491,000 to 509,000 ($500,000 + \text{or} - 9,000$)
- * There are approximately nineteen chances in twenty that the real value falls within the range 482,000 to 518,000 ($500,000 + \text{or} - 18,000$)

The real value in this case is the result we would obtain if we could enumerate the total population.

MOVEMENT ESTIMATES

The following example illustrates how to use the standard error to interpret a movement estimate. Let us say that one month the published level estimate for females employed part time in Australia is 1,387,000; the next month the published level estimate is 1,400,000. The calculated standard error for the level estimates is 9,800. The standard error is then used to interpret the published movement estimate of +13,000. For instance, the standard error of 9,800 indicates that:

- There are approximately two chances in three that the real movement over the two month period falls within the range 3,200 to 22,800 ($13,000 + \text{or} - 9,800$)
- There are approximately nineteen chances in twenty that the real movement falls within the range -6,600 to 32,600 ($13,000 + \text{or} - 19,600$).

WHAT IF...? REVISIONS TO TREND ESTIMATES

EFFECT OF NEW SEASONALLY ADJUSTED ESTIMATES ON TREND ESTIMATES

Each time new seasonally adjusted estimates become available, trend estimates are revised (see paragraphs 13 and 14 of Explanatory Notes).


TREND REVISIONS

The examples in the tables below show four illustrative scenarios and the consequent revisions to previous trend estimates of employment and unemployment rate.

- 1** The March seasonally adjusted estimate is the same as the February estimate.
- 2** The March seasonally adjusted estimate is higher than the February estimate by:
 - +0.33% for employment
 - +2.3% for the unemployment rate
- 3** The March seasonally adjusted estimate is lower than the February estimate by:
 - -0.33% for employment
 - -2.3% for the unemployment rate
- 4** The March seasonally adjusted estimate results in a revised February trend estimate which is identical to the new March trend estimate.

The percentage changes of 0.33% and 2.3% were chosen because they represent the average monthly percentage changes in employment and the unemployment rate respectively.


EMPLOYMENT ('000)
