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## P R E F A C E


The 1966 Census publication programme is made up of five individual Volumes, four consisting of a number of separate Parts, together with a series of supplementary statements in mimeographed form. The actual titles of the 1966 Census Volumes and Parts are listed in the back of this publication; the content of each is briefly as follows:

- Volume 1.** Single characteristics of the population for Australia, Parts 1-11.—Age, marital status, birthplace, nationality, period of residence, education, religion, occupational status, industry, occupation and race.
- Volume 2.** Related characteristics of the population for Australia, Parts 1-5.—Growth and distribution of the population, demographic data, overseas-born population, the work force, and families and households.
- Volume 3.** Housing.
- Volume 4.** Single characteristics of the population and dwellings in Local Government Areas, Parts 1-7.—New South Wales, Victoria, Queensland, South Australia, Western Australia, Tasmania, and Northern Territory and Australian Capital Territory.
- Volume 5.** Population and dwellings in localities, Parts 1-7.—States and Territories as for Volume 4, and Part 8.—Australia.

This publication is Part 2 of Volume 2 and contains details of fertility analysis as enumerated at 30 June 1966.

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# EXPLANATORY NOTES

## Form of the Inquiry

The question concerning issue at each of the Censuses of 1947, 1954, 1961 and 1966 was phrased in almost identical terms. In 1966 the question was: 'Family born to existing marriage (excluding stillborn). For each person at present married, state the number (both living and dead) born to existing marriage. If no family born, write "0". Exclude those born to previous marriages'.

In 1911 and 1921 particulars of issue to previous marriages were also collected.

In 1933 the question regarding issue was omitted from the Census Schedule, although that referring to duration of existing marriage was retained.

A question concerning duration of existing marriage has been included in all censuses since 1911.

The 1911 tabulations of issue covered all marriages, for both husbands and wives, and also existing marriages for wives only. In addition, particulars of issue of widowed and divorced persons were tabulated for the only time at an Australian census. The 1921 tabulations also related to total issue, both of all marriages and existing marriages, but were restricted to husbands and wives enumerated together on census night. Subsequent tabulations have related to issue of existing marriages only. In 1947 these particulars were tabulated for husbands and wives, but in 1954, 1961 and 1966 they were tabulated for wives only.

In 1961 and 1966 adopted children and foster children with the same family name as the wife were counted as issue, because householders frequently failed to differentiate between issue and adopted children.

These differences in tabulation are important, and should be borne in mind when comparisons are being made between the results of the various censuses.

## Fertility Analysis

The inquiry was limited to married women, and excluded those permanently separated, widowed or divorced. Women whose husbands were absent on census night were included.

For the 1961 and 1966 Censuses tabulations were prepared for each State and Territory, and for Australia as a whole. Previously they had been prepared only for Australia.

The major cross-classification for 1961 was age of wife at census by age at marriage for the existing marriage, unlike previous censuses, which were classified mainly according to duration of marriage.

For 1966 fertility tables both duration of marriage and age of wife by age at marriage for the existing marriage were used as bases for cross-classification.

The availability of computer facilities at the 1966 Census allowed the processing of fertility analysis data for all married women included in the family analysis. In the 1954 and 1961 Censuses fertility analysis tables were derived from a 20 per cent sample of the married women enumerated. For details of sampling and processing procedures see relevant Statistician's Reports.

The use of 100 per cent analysis at the 1966 Census as opposed to the 20 per cent sampling procedures used for fertility analyses at the 1954 and 1961 Censuses should be borne in mind, as well as differences in tabulations (previously mentioned) when making comparisons between fertility analysis tables for the various censuses.

A further difference resulting from the change to computer processing is the increased proportion of wives with husbands absent, 6.4 per cent in 1966 against 4.8 per cent in 1961. In 1966 the linking of data for husbands and wives was done automatically by reference to the family codes of each, i.e. family number and relationship to the head of the family. As persons enumerated in non-private dwellings were not allocated to families, all married women enumerated in such dwellings were treated as having husbands absent whereas under the previous clerical system it was possible to identify families in some non-private dwellings.

## Individual Characteristics of Husband and Wife

### Age

Persons were asked to state age in accordance with the following instructions.

State age in years and completed months. If aged under one year, state age in completed months (for example, a child of eleven months should be shown as '0' years '11' months). If aged under one month, write '0' years '0' months.

This question is more specific than that asked at the 1961 Census, which sought 'age last birthday' (in years). The change should overcome some mis-statement of age due to rounding. Similarly, it is expected that confusion in the reporting of ages of young children (which are conventionally thought of in 'months' up to the age of about two years) should be now largely obviated.

Prior to the 1954 Census ages 'not stated' were tabulated as such for urban and rural sections of each State and later distributed to specific ages in accordance with the frequency of stated ages. In the 1954 and later Censuses, 'not stated' ages were individually estimated prior to tabulation by first establishing the minimum range of ages within which the 'not stated' age most probably lay (as indicated by other information supplied in the Householder's Schedule) and by then selecting an age from within that range from a table of random ages according to sex. This table had been compiled previously using the latest estimates of the age distribution of the population which were available at the time.

The proportion of persons who failed to state an age is very small.

## **Marital status**

Persons were asked to state marital status in accordance with the following instructions.

If never married write 'N.M.'; at present married, write 'M'; married but permanently separated (legally or otherwise), write 'P.S.'; divorced and not remarried, write 'D'; widowed and not remarried, write 'W'.

A very small proportion of persons omitted to state any marital status. In such cases, marital status was assessed as follows.

Males under 20 years of age and females under 18 years of age were classified 'never married' unless there was definite evidence of marriage given in the Schedule, in which case they were classified 'married'. All other persons were classified 'married' if there was any evidence of marriage given in the Schedule. Otherwise a marital status was allocated from a random list according to the age and sex of the person concerned. The random list for the allocation of 'not stated' marital status had been compiled previously using the latest available statistics of the distribution of the population by marital status.

## **Duration of existing marriage**

Persons were asked to state the duration of the existing marriage in accordance with the following instructions:

For each person at present *married* state the number of completed years the existing marriage has been in force. *Exclude* previous marriages. If married less than one year, write '0'.

## **Birthplace**

Persons were asked to state birthplace in accordance with the following instructions.

For persons born in Australia write name of the State or Territory where born. For persons born outside Australia write the name of the country where born (not town or locality).

For the small number of cases where no reply was given, the allocation of a birthplace was made in accordance with other information on the Schedule (usually nationality).

## **Period of residence in Australia**

Persons were asked to state period of residence in Australia in accordance with the following instructions.

For persons born outside Australia write the number of completed years of continuous residence in Australia ignoring absences of less than twelve months. If resident less than twelve months, write '0'.

## **Education**

At the 1966 Census persons were asked to state the highest level of schooling completed in accordance with the instructions below. This question had not been asked at previous Censuses.

### **NEW SOUTH WALES**

For each person state the highest level of schooling completed.

If passed at Leaving or Matriculation level, write 'M'. If passed at Intermediate level, write 'J'. If attended secondary school (e.g. high, technical, non-Government) but passed no examinations at Intermediate level or above, write 'H'. If attended or completed infants' or primary school or passed final primary examinations such as Qualifying Certificate (Q.C.), Merit or High School Entrance, write 'P'. If never attended school, write 'N'.

### **VICTORIA**

For each person state the highest level of schooling completed.

If passed at Leaving or Matriculation level, write 'M'. If passed at Intermediate level, write 'J'. If attended secondary school (e.g. high, technical, non-Government) but passed no examinations at Intermediate level or above, write 'H'. If attended or completed infants' or primary school or passed final primary examinations such as Qualifying Certificate (Q.C.), or Merit, write 'P'. If never attended school, write 'N'.

### **QUEENSLAND**

For each person state the highest level of schooling completed.

If passed at Senior or Matriculation level, write 'M'. If passed at Junior level, write 'J'. If attended secondary school (e.g. high, technical, non-Government) but passed no examinations at Junior level or above, write 'H'. If attended or completed infants' or primary school or passed final primary examinations such as the Scholarships or High School Entrance, write 'P'. If never attended school, write 'N'.

### **SOUTH AUSTRALIA**

For each person state the highest level of schooling completed.

If passed at Leaving or Leaving Honours level, write 'M'. If passed at Intermediate level, write 'J'. If attended secondary school (e.g. high, technical, non-Government) but passed no examinations at Intermediate level or above, write 'H'. If attended or completed infants' or primary school or passed final primary examination such as Qualifying Certificate (Q.C.), Progress Certificate or Inspectors' Examination, write 'P'. If never attended school, write 'N'.

## WESTERN AUSTRALIA

For each person state the highest level of schooling completed.

If passed at Leaving or Matriculation level, write 'M'. If passed at Junior level, write 'J'. If attended secondary school (e.g. high, technical, non-Government, post primary) but passed no examinations at Junior level or above, write 'H'. If attended or completed infants' or primary school or passed final primary examinations such as Qualifying Certificate (Q.C.), or Scholarship, write 'P'. If never attended school, write 'N'.

## TASMANIA

For each person state the highest level of schooling completed.

If passed at Matriculation or Schools Board (A and B certificate) level, write 'M'. If passed at Secondary School Certificate or Schools Board (C certificate) level, write 'J'. If attended secondary school (e.g. high, technical, non-Government) but passed no examinations at Secondary School Certificate level or above, write 'H'. If attended or completed infants' or primary school or passed final primary examinations such as Qualifying Certificate (Q.C.), Scholarship or Merit, write 'P'. If never attended school, write 'N'.

## NORTHERN TERRITORY

For each person state the highest level of schooling completed.

If passed at Leaving, Matriculation, Senior or Schools Board (A and B certificate) level, write 'M'. If passed at Intermediate, Junior or Secondary School Certificate level, write 'J'. If attended secondary school (e.g. high, technical, non-Government, post primary) but passed no examination at Intermediate, etc., level or above, write 'H'. If attended or completed infants' or primary school or passed final primary examinations such as Qualifying Certificate (Q.C.), Merit, High School Entrance, Scholarship, etc., write 'P'. If never attended school, write 'N'.

## AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY

For each person state the highest level of schooling completed.

If passed at Leaving, Matriculation, Senior or Schools Board (A and B certificate) level, write 'M'. If passed at Intermediate, Junior or Secondary School Certificate level, write 'J'. If attended secondary school (e.g. high, technical, non-Government, post primary) but passed no examination at Intermediate, etc., level or above, write 'H'. If attended or completed infants' or primary school or passed final primary examinations such as Qualifying Certificate (Q.C.), Merit, High School Entrance, Scholarship, etc., write 'P'. If never attended school, write 'N'.

Persons who received their highest level of schooling overseas, or in another Australian State or Territory were asked to give what they considered to be the equivalent in terms of the above categories.

It was intended that persons attending secondary school who had not passed examinations at Intermediate level should answer 'H'. However, this intention was obscured by the use of the past tense in the instruction, with the result that some secondary school students were either recorded as having attended primary school ('P') or the level of schooling was not stated.

To provide for this misunderstanding, all 12, 13 and 14 year olds shown as 'P' were redistributed as 'P' or 'H' in proportion with age distributions obtained from the Department of Education.

In the cases where education level was not stated for children aged 0-16 years the level was determined as follows. Children aged 0-11 years were classified 'never attended school' or 'primary' according to relevant information on the Schedule (particularly activity). Children aged 12-14 years were allocated in accordance with the proportion of children of each age in primary and secondary school as recorded by the Department of Education during the intercensal period. Children aged 15 or 16 years were classified 'secondary' where other information on the Schedule showed them to be still attending school.

## Qualifications

In addition to the above, which relates to level of schooling, persons with qualifications received after completion of formal schooling were required to supply information in accordance with the following instructions.

State the person's qualifications, trade training or other qualifications and the institution at which obtained, e.g. Bachelor of Engineering, University of Sydney; Diploma of Architecture, South Australian Institute of Technology; A.A.S.A.; Certificate of Management, Hobart Technical College; Five years' Apprenticeship.

The information obtained was used to determine two additional levels of completed education, namely: University degree and other tertiary qualifications. Particulars of individual qualifications are not available.

## Religion

Persons were asked to state their religion in accordance with the following instructions.

State the full name of the religious denomination. (There is no penalty for failure to answer this question.)

Section 21 of the *Census and Statistics Act 1905-1966* provides that 'No person shall be liable to any penalty for omitting or refusing to state the religious denomination or sect to which he belongs or adheres'.

Owing to the very large numbers of persons who take advantage of the voluntary nature of the question and who failed to give any particulars regarding religion at the 1966 Census and at the three preceding censuses, it is not possible to define precisely the composition of the population in terms of religious creed; neither is it possible to make entirely satisfactory intercensal comparisons of the numbers of persons adhering to the various religious denominations.

#### Migratory population

The migratory population consists of persons who, at midnight between 30 June 1966 and 1 July 1966, were enumerated on board ships in Australian ports, or ships which had left an Australian port prior to census night with a next port of call in Australia. It also includes persons, who at census time, were enumerated on long-distance trains, motor coaches or aircraft.

#### Aborigines

All tables in this Part exclude persons who described themselves as being more than 50 per cent Aboriginal or who described themselves as being 'Aboriginal'.

#### Note

(1) Although careful efforts are made to keep errors in the Census to a minimum, the large and complex task of processing Census data invariably results in minor discrepancies between the Census results produced at different stages of the Census programme. Because of the complexity of processing, and the fact that tabulations are produced progressively, it is frequently not practicable to rectify such small discrepancies. Consequently, some differences will be evident between tables included in a particular Census publication, as well as between a particular Census publication and previous publications. In all such cases the differences are small (generally no more than 0.02 per cent) and in no way affect the general validity of the Census results.

(2) Any discrepancies between totals and sums of components in tables showing percentages are due to rounding.
