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

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MAIN FINDINGS

- At 30 June 1995 the Northern Territory estimated resident population was 173,878 people. This represented an increase of 1.6% over the previous financial year figure of 171,072. In comparison the national average increase was 1.1%, (NSW 1.0%, Vic 0.5%, Qld 2.5%, SA 0.3%, WA 1.8%, Tas 0.1%, ACT 1.0%).
- The estimated resident population of Darwin City (SSD) remained static for financial year 1994-95. Despite this several suburbs had marked increases in population with City Inner 11.9%, Larrakeyah 6.7% and Stuart Park 6.9% the most notable.
- During the 1994-95 financial year the population of Palmerston grew faster than any other centre in the Northern Territory recording an increase in resident population of 9.1% to 12,237 persons. Within Palmerston, Woodroffe experienced the greatest growth with 17.2%, followed by Driver 9.7%, Moulden 7.2% and Gray 6.7%. The surrounding area of Litchfield grew by 4.8% to 12,195 persons.
- The population of Alice Springs passed the 25,000 mark for the first time with an increase of 0.9% to 25,090 persons. Katherine's population rose to 8,800 persons, an increase of 0.7%. Jabiru reversed its previous decline, increasing by 1.0% to 1,370 persons. Tennant Creek experienced a decline in resident population losing 66 persons, a decrease of 2.1%.
- Population growth in the Gulf region continued with an increase in resident population of 1.8% to 2,525 persons. Daly (SLA) rose to 3,730 persons, an increase of 2.7%.
- At 30 June 1995, the Northern Territory was the only State or Territory with a median age less than 30 years (28.3 years). By comparison South Australia had the highest median age (35.1 years) followed by New South Wales (34.1 years), Tasmania (34.1 years), Victoria (33.9 years), Queensland (33.0 years, Western Australia (32.9 years) and the Australian Capital Territory (30.7 years).
- Darwin's population had a median age of 30 years and only 3.3 per cent of its population is over the age of 65 years. The Darwin suburbs with the youngest median age populations were City Remainder (25 years), Wagaman (26 years) and Wulagi (27 years). Fannie Bay and The Gardens (35 years), and Parap (33 years), have the oldest median age populations.
- A selection of other median age populations for the Northern Territory were Alice Springs (28 years), Katherine (27 years), Tennant Creek (27 years) and Palmerston (27 years). Areas with high proportions of indigenous populations tended to have lower median ages as reflected by East Arnhem (21 years), West Arnhem (22 years) and Victoria (22 years).

- The following graph gives percentage change in resident population for Northern Territory Local Government Areas for the period June 1994 to June 1995. The average variation for the period was plus 2.11%.



MAP 1 STATISTICAL LOCAL AREAS, NORTHERN TERRITORY




MAP 2 STATISTICAL LOCAL AREAS, DARWIN

EXPLANATORY NOTES

INTRODUCTION

This publication contains estimates of the resident population by age and sex in statistical local areas (SLAs) in the Northern Territory at 30 June 1994 and 30 June 1995.

The estimated resident population (ERP) is the official ABS estimate of the Australian population. The ERP for 30 June 1994 and 30 June 1995 is based on results of the Census of Population and Housing held on 6 August 1991, and numbers of births, deaths, and estimates of interstate and overseas migration in 1993/94 and 1994/95.

ERP is compiled according to the place of usual residence of the population. An explanation of the conceptual basis used is given in the ABS Information Paper, *Population Estimates: An Outline of the New Conceptual Basis of ABS Population Estimates* (3216.0).

METHODOLOGY FOR DERIVING ERP FROM CENSUS FOR TOTAL NORTHERN TERRITORY AT CENSUS DATE

The figures at the Census date were arrived at by —

- adjusting the Census counts (place of enumeration basis) to obtain counts on the basis of usual residence (Census count, place of usual residence)
- adjusting the Census counts, place of usual residence, for Census under-enumeration
- adding to the adjusted Census counts, place of usual residence, the number of Northern Territory residents temporarily overseas at the time of the Census.

A survey is conducted after the Census to measure under-enumeration during the Census. Adjustments are calculated separately for the Indigenous and non-Indigenous components of the population. These adjustments are calculated from the result of the under-enumeration survey and other demographic measures. A more detailed explanation is available on request.

TOTAL NORTHERN TERRITORY ESTIMATE BACKDATED TO 30 JUNE 1991

The methods described above are used to derive the Northern Territory population figures for 6 August 1991. The figures for 30 June 1991 were derived by estimating the components of change between 1 July and 6 August and subtracting them from 6 August figures. See the *Australian Demographic Quarterly Statistics* (3101.0), December quarter 1992 for the data associated with the State and Territory adjustments.

TOTAL NORTHERN TERRITORY ESTIMATE IN 1994 AND 1995

The "components of change" for estimating growth between 30 June for any two periods for State/Territory ERP include numbers of births and deaths; estimates of interstate migration (derived from Medicare data); and numbers of overseas migrants.

DERIVING ESTIMATES AT SLA LEVEL

Estimates at SLA level detailed in this issue were derived from a model which apportions the total Northern Territory ERP for 1991 according to changes in the Family Allowance (Department of Social Security) and ABS building survey data.

GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES

The geographic areas used in this publication are defined in the *Australian Standard Geographic Classification Edition 2.4* (1216.0).

SLA boundaries used for determining the 1994 and 1995 ERP are those in existence at 30 June 1991.

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
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
