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P R E F A C E

The 1966 Census publication programme is made up of six individual Volumes, each consisting of a number of separate Parts, together with a series of supplementary statements in mimeographed form. The actual titles of the 1966 Census Volumes and Parts are listed in the back of this publication; the content of each is briefly as follows:

- Volume 1. Single characteristics of population for Australia, Parts 1-11.—Age, marital status, birthplace, nationality, period of residence, education, religion, occupational status, industry, occupation, and race.
- Volume 2. Related characteristics of population for Australia, Parts 1-5.—Growth and distribution of the population, demographic data, overseas-born population, the work force, and families and households.
- Volume 3. Housing.
- Volume 4. Single characteristics of the population and dwellings in Local Government Areas, Parts 1-7.—New South Wales, Victoria, Queensland, South Australia, Western Australia, Tasmania, and Northern Territory and Australian Capital Territory.
- Volume 5. Population and dwellings in localities, Parts 1-7.—States and Territories as for Volume 4, and Part 8.—Australia.
- Volume 6. Statistician's Report, Parts 1-6.—Introduction, preparation for the Census, the enumeration, processing the data, dissemination of results, and evaluation

This publication is Part 7 of Volume 4 and contains details of the population and dwellings enumerated in Police Districts and Administrative Divisions, and their urban and rural components, in the Northern Territory and the Australian Capital Territory respectively.

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
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EXPLANATORY NOTES

General

Delimitation of urban centres

The principles and criteria used for the delimitation of urban centres in Australia at the 1966 Census were as follows:

A boundary was defined for all settlements with a population of 1,000 or more and these were named 'urban centres' except for the State capitals and Canberra which were named 'Metropolitan areas'. This boundary is one which, from census to census, as urbanisation proceeds, will be moved outwards to encompass any peripheral urban development.

For urban centres with a population of 30,000 and over, and for a few smaller centres, the following criteria were adopted for delimiting the urban centres.

- (a) The Metropolitan Area or urban centre was delimited by including all contiguous Census collector's districts with a population density of 500 or more persons per square mile.
- (b) Certain collector's districts, although not reaching the required population density were also included by virtue of—
 - (i) land use (e.g. factory areas),
 - (ii) being surrounded by urban collector's districts,
 - (iii) forming a 'bridge' between two urban centres less than two miles apart so that they could be regarded as one single urban centre.

For urban centres of less than 30,000 population, local government area boundaries were adopted, unless they contained a large rural component or urban development was known to extend beyond the local government boundary. In these cases they were delimited by inspection of aerial photographs, by field inspection, or by consideration of any other information available, and the boundaries were set as closely as possible to the periphery of the built-up area without regard to local government boundaries.

In areas with large numbers of holiday homes, many of which are unoccupied at the mid-winter census date, dwelling rather than population criteria were used. These criteria were 250 dwellings (in lieu of the 1,000 population mentioned above) and 125 dwellings per square mile (in lieu of the 500 persons per square mile mentioned above). Around each metropolitan area and urban centre with a population of at least 75,000 and a regional population of at least 100,000, a further boundary was defined, designed to circumscribe an area which would contain the urban development of that centre for at least twenty years and which would generally be socially and economically oriented to the centre. These areas were designated 'Statistical Divisions' (for State capital cities) or 'Statistical Districts' (for Canberra, Newcastle, Wollongong and Geelong).

Because the new criteria for the delimitation of urban boundaries were adopted only shortly prior to the 1966 Census a few collector's districts containing urban growth were not split into their rural and (potentially) urban components, with the result that significant urban population remained included in large, predominantly rural, collector's districts, which did not meet the density criterion. Such cases occurred mainly around the Sydney Metropolitan Area and Urban Toowoomba. The effect on the Sydney Metropolitan Area is small, probably not more than 5,000 urban population having been omitted. In Toowoomba the effect is proportionately much greater, the urban population probably being understated by up to 3,000 persons.

Application of the new criteria in the Northern Territory was limited, for the 1966 Census, to Urban Darwin. The first map at the back of this publication shows the relationship of Urban Darwin, as delimited under the new criteria, to the administrative area of the City of Darwin and the proposed area of Greater Darwin. Separate figures are shown in this publication for the Darwin Police District, the City of Darwin, Urban Darwin, and the Urban centres of Alice Springs, Katherine and Tennant Creek.

Canberra was delimited by a number of boundaries each with its own distinctive purpose and interest. The boundaries used were (i) the Canberra Statistical District, which includes the Canberra Metropolitan Area, the Municipality of Queanbeyan in New South Wales and part of the rural area of the Australian Capital Territory, (ii) the Canberra Metropolitan Area, which is the urban centre of Canberra, and (iii) the Canberra City District, which is the boundary that delineates the proclaimed administrative area of Canberra on 30 June 1966.

Separate figures are shown in this publication for Canberra Metropolitan Area, Canberra City District (which includes those parts of R.A.A.F. Base, Fairbairn, Canberra Airport and H.M.A.S. Harman, which are situated beyond the Canberra City District boundary) and rural. 'Rural' includes all areas which did not meet the criteria used in the delimitation of urban centres. It therefore includes, for example, new residential areas in an early stage of development which have not yet reached the required minimum urban density of 500 persons per square mile.

Apart from the Canberra Metropolitan Area, the Australian Capital Territory has no population clusters of 1,000 or more persons and therefore no 'urban centres' were designated.

Persons having diplomatic immunity (diplomatic and home-based staff of diplomatic missions, and their families) are not included. The number of such persons in the Australian Capital Territory at 30 June 1966 was approximately 1,200. Dwellings occupied by persons having diplomatic immunity were also excluded.

Migratory population

The migratory population consists of persons who, at midnight between 30 June 1966 and 1 July 1966, were enumerated on board ships in Australian ports, or ships which had left an Australian port prior to census night with a next port of call in Australia. It also includes persons, who at census time, were enumerated on long-distance trains, motor coaches or aircraft.

Aborigines

All tables in this Part exclude persons who described themselves as being more than 50 per cent Aboriginal or who described themselves as being 'Aboriginal'. Dwellings occupied solely by such persons are also excluded from tables 9, 10 and 11.

Individual Characteristics

Age

Persons were asked to state age in accordance with the following instructions.

State age in years and completed months. If aged under one year, state age in completed months (for example, a child of eleven months should be shown as '0' years '11' months). If aged under one month, write '0' years '0' months.

This question is more specific than that asked at the 1961 Census, which sought 'age last birthday' (in years). The change should overcome some mis-statement of age due to rounding. Similarly, it is expected that confusion in the reporting of ages of young children (which are conventionally thought of in 'months' up to the age of about two years) should be now largely obviated.

Prior to the 1954 Census ages 'not stated' were tabulated as such for urban and rural sections of each State and later distributed to specific ages in accordance with the frequency of stated ages. In the 1954 and later Censuses, 'not stated' ages were individually estimated prior to tabulation by first establishing the minimum range of ages within which the 'not stated' age most probably lay (as indicated by other information supplied in the Householder's Schedule) and by then selecting an age from within that range from a table of random ages according to sex. This table had been compiled previously using the latest estimates of the age distribution of the population which were available at the time.

The proportion of persons who failed to state an age is very small.

Marital status

Persons were asked to state marital status in accordance with the following instructions.

If never married, write 'N.M.'; at present married, write 'M'; married but permanently separated (legally or otherwise), write 'P.S.'; divorced and not remarried, write 'D'; widowed and not remarried, write 'W'.

A very small proportion of persons omitted to state any marital status. In such cases, marital status was assessed as follows.

Males under 20 years of age and females under 18 years of age were classified 'never married' unless there was definite evidence of marriage given in the Schedule, in which case they were classified 'married'. All other persons were classified 'married' if there was any evidence of marriage given in the Schedule. Otherwise a marital status was allocated from a random list according to the age and sex of the person concerned. The random list for the allocation of 'not stated' marital status had been compiled previously using the latest available statistics of the distribution of the population by marital status.

Birthplace

Persons were asked to state birthplace in accordance with the following instructions.

For persons born in Australia write name of the State or Territory where born. For persons born outside Australia write the name of the country where born (not town or locality).

For the small number of cases where no reply was given, the allocation of a birthplace was made in accordance with other information on the Schedule (usually nationality).

Nationality

Persons were asked to state nationality in accordance with the following instructions.

State nationality or citizenship of the person in relation to the country to which he or she owes legal allegiance, for example: 'Australian', 'British', 'French', 'Stateless', etc. If Australian or British by naturalization, write 'Australian' or 'British'.

This section relates to nationality rather than to citizenship and consequently the category 'British' includes all persons who, by virtue of the *Nationality and Citizenship Act* 1948–1966, are deemed to be British subjects. Under Section 7 of the Act this includes citizens of: (a) the United Kingdom and Colonies; (b) Canada; (c) New Zealand; (d) the Union of South Africa; (e) India; (f) Pakistan; (g) Ceylon; (h) the Federation of Rhodesia and Nyasaland; (i) Ghana; (j) the Federation of Malaya; (k) the State of Singapore'.

Also included as 'British' are persons who, under the *Nationality and Citizenship Act* 1948–1966, are Australian citizens or citizens of any other country declared by Regulation 5A of the Citizenship Regulations to be 'a country within the Commonwealth of Nations'. These are the Federation of Nigeria, the Republic of Cyprus, Sierra Leone, Tanganyika, Trinidad and Tobago, Uganda, Jamaica, and Malaysia.

Additionally, in this publication, Irish nationality is included with British.

In the small number of cases where nationality was not stated, allocation of a selected nationality was made in accordance with other information on the Schedule (usually birthplace).

Period of residence in Australia

Persons were asked to state period of residence in Australia in accordance with the following instructions.

For persons born outside Australia write the number of completed years of continuous residence in Australia ignoring absences of less than twelve months. If resident less than twelve months, write '0'.

Education

Persons in the Northern Territory were asked to state their level of education in accordance with the following instructions.

For each person state the highest level of schooling completed.

If passed at Leaving, Matriculation, Senior or Schools Board (A and B certificate) level, write 'M'. If passed at Intermediate, Junior or Secondary School Certificate level, write 'J'. If attended secondary school (e.g., high, technical, non-Government, post primary) but passed no examination at Intermediate, etc., level or above, write 'H'. If attended or completed infants' or primary school or passed final primary examinations such as Qualifying Certificate (O.C.), Merit, High School Entrance, Scholarship, etc., write 'P'. If never attended school, write 'N'.

Note: For persons whose highest level of schooling was received overseas, or in another Australian State or Territory, give what is considered to be the equivalent in terms of the above categories.

Persons in the Australian Capital Territory were asked to state their level of education in accordance with the following instructions.

For each person state the highest level of schooling completed.

If passed at Leaving, Matriculation, Senior or Schools Board (A and B certificate) level, write 'M'. If passed at Intermediate, Junior or Secondary School Certificate level, write 'J'. If attended secondary school (e.g., high, technical, non-Government, post primary) but passed no examination at Intermediate etc., level or above, write 'H'. If attended or completed infants' or primary school or passed final primary examinations such as Qualifying Certificate (O.C.), Merit, High School Entrance, Scholarship, etc., write 'P'. If never attended school, write 'N'.

Note: For persons whose highest level of schooling was received overseas, or in another Australian State or Territory, give what is considered to be the equivalent in terms of the above categories.

In addition to the above, which relates to level of schooling, persons with qualifications received after completion of formal schooling were required to supply information in accordance with the following instructions.

State the person's qualifications, trade training or other qualifications and the institution at which obtained, e.g., Bachelor of Engineering, University of Sydney; Diploma of Architecture, South Australian Institute of Technology; A.A.S.A.; Certificate of Management, Hobart Technical College; Five years' Apprenticeship.

The information obtained was used to determine two additional levels of completed education, namely: University degree and other tertiary qualifications. Particulars of individual qualifications are not available.

It was intended that persons *attending* secondary school who had not passed examinations at intermediate level should answer 'H'. However, this intention was obscured by the use of the past tense in the instruction, with the result that some secondary school students were either recorded as having attended primary school ('P') or the level of schooling was not stated.

To provide for this misunderstanding, all 12, 13 and 14 year olds shown as 'P' were redistributed as 'P' or 'H' in proportion with age distributions obtained from the Department of Education.

In the cases where education level was not stated for children aged 0-16 years the level was determined as follows. Children aged 0-11 years were classified 'never attended school' or 'primary' according to relevant information on the Schedule (particularly activity). Children aged 12-14 years were allocated in accordance with the proportion of children of each age in primary and secondary school as recorded by the Department of Education during the intercensal period. Children aged 15 or 16 years were classified 'secondary' where other information on the Schedule showed them to be still attending school.

Religion

Persons were asked to state their religion in accordance with the following instructions.

State the full name of the religious denomination. (There is no penalty for failure to answer this question.)

Section 21 of the *Census and Statistics Act 1905-1966* provides that 'No person shall be liable to any penalty for omitting or refusing to state the religious denomination or sect to which he belongs or adheres'.

Owing to the very large numbers of persons who take advantage of the voluntary nature of the question and who failed to give any particulars regarding religion at the 1966 Census and at the three preceding censuses, it is not possible to define precisely the composition of the population in terms of religious creed; neither is it possible to make entirely satisfactory intercensal comparisons of the numbers of persons adhering to the various religious denominations.

Work force

At the 1961 and previous Censuses the work force was determined as:

- 'Those who are engaged in an industry, business, profession, trade or service at the time of the Census (including those on long service leave, etc.).....'; and
'.....those out of a job at time of the Census but who are usually engaged in an industry, business, profession, trade or service.....'

At the 1966 Census an additional set of four questions was asked in order to obtain information on the basis of which the work force could be determined more precisely. The *questions* were as follows.

Did the person have a job or business of any kind last week (even though he may have been temporarily absent from it)? ANSWER 'YES' or 'NO'.

Did the person do any work **at all** last week for payment or profit? ANSWER 'YES' or 'NO'. Persons working without pay as a helper in a 'family business' or farm and members of the clergy and of religious orders (other than purely contemplative orders) should answer 'YES' to this question. **Persons doing only unpaid housework should answer 'NO'.**

Was the person temporarily laid off by his employer without pay for the **whole** of last week? ANSWER 'YES' or 'NO'.

Did the person look for work last week? ANSWER 'YES' or 'NO'. (**Note:** 'Looking for work' means (i) being registered with Commonwealth Employment Service, or (ii) approaching prospective employers, or (iii) placing or answering advertisements, or (iv) writing letters of application, or (v) awaiting the result of recent applications.)

The work force includes all persons for whom the answer 'yes' was given to any one of these four questions. Except that persons helping but not receiving wages or a salary who usually worked less than 15 hours a week were excluded from the work force.

This approach conforms closely to the recommendations of the Eighth International Conference of Labour Statisticians held in Geneva in 1954 and the information so obtained has been used in determining the work force for the purposes of the 1966 Census.

The net effect of the new definition is to include approximately 74 and 1,200 additional persons in the work force in the Northern Territory and in the Australian Capital Territory respectively, i.e. a proportionate increase in the work force of the Northern Territory and the Australian Capital Territory of 0.39 and 2.72 per cent respectively. The major factor in this change was females working part-time (sometimes for only a few hours a week) some of whom, in 1961, did not consider themselves as '.....engaged in an industry, business, profession, trade or service'.

Occupational status

Persons in the work force were asked to state occupational status in accordance with the following instructions.

If working for wages or salary (including apprentices), write 'W'.

If conducting own business or profession and **not** at present employing others, write 'O'.

If conducting own business or profession and at present employing others, write 'E'.

If helping but not receiving wages or salary, write 'H'.

If looking for first job, write 'F'.

Persons not in the work force were asked to state activity in accordance with the following instructions.

Persons **not engaged** in an industry, business, profession, trade or service.

For—Children not attending school, write 'C'. Full-time students or children attending school, write 'S'. Mainly dependent on pension or superannuation, write 'P'. Of independent means, write 'M'. Engaged in unpaid home duties, write 'H.D.'. Inmates of institutions (e.g., for invalids and the aged, gaols, reformatories, etc.) write 'I'. Others not engaged in industry, etc., write 'N.A.'. (Young persons seeking work but not previously employed, write 'O' in answer to this question.)

Industry

Persons in the work force were asked to state industry in accordance with the following instructions.

State the exact branch of industry, business or service in which mainly engaged last week using two or more words where possible. For example, 'Dairy Farming', 'Coal Mining', 'Woollen Mills', 'Retail Grocery', 'Road Construction', etc. Employees should state the industry of their employer. For example, a carpenter employed by a coal mining company should state 'Coal Mining'. If employed by a Government Department or other public body, state also its name. For paid housekeepers and domestic servants in private households, write 'P.H.'.

From the answers to this question, persons were classified according to the Bureau's 'Classification of Industries' which provides for each person to be classified according to the nature of the business in which mainly engaged, regardless of whether operated by a government authority, corporation or individual.

Occupation

Persons in the work force were asked to state occupation in accordance with the following instructions.

State in precise (or award) terms the person's main occupation last week, using where possible two or more words. For example, 'Builder's Labourer', 'Dairy Farm Hand', 'Clothing Machinist', 'Wood Machinist', 'Motor Mechanic', 'Electrical Fitter', 'Coal Wheeler', 'Dairy Farmer', etc. Employees of Government Departments or Authorities should be described by their official designation, such as 'District Employment Officer', 'Shire Clerk', etc., and not by such terms as 'Public Servant', etc.

The precise classification of persons in the work force according to occupation and industry is extremely difficult but is subject to continuing efforts to improve the quality of the data from census to census. Consequently the comparison of data compiled at the 1966 Census with that obtained at previous censuses is not only influenced by changes in the definition and content of the work force but also by the different responses which may have been evoked by efforts to improve the questions on the census schedule, and by some changes in coding rules designed to rectify known deficiencies in the data. Classification according to occupation and industry is difficult mainly because of the problem of conveying through a printed form the exact nature of the information required (e.g. the conceptual difference between 'occupation' and 'industry') and the consequential inadequacy of many replies.

Classification according to occupation is particularly difficult because: (a) the range of occupations is so extensive; (b) there is a lack of uniformity in occupational terms, which vary between industries, locations and States; and (c) respondents fail to give precise descriptions, especially of other members of the family, either through carelessness or ignorance of occupational designations. Similarly, classification according to industry is complicated by the development of new fields of industrial enterprise and the splitting and overlapping of previously identifiable fields.

While it is not intended to revise any of the statistics relating to occupation and industry contained in this publication, it is proposed to undertake a detailed analysis of the information obtained at the 1966 Census to evaluate the precision of the data and as an aid to the framing of classifications and the wording of instructions for the next census.

In this publication space limitations do not allow publication of the full range of the classifications of all population characteristics for each police district or administrative division. However, more extensive information is available on request from the Commonwealth Statistician or from the Chief Statistics Officer, Darwin. Tables 12 to 21 show for the Northern Territory and the Australian Capital Territory as a whole the full range of data that has been tabulated for police districts or administrative divisions.

Dwellings definitions

The following definitions were used as a basis for the Census of Dwellings.

- (a) An 'occupied dwelling' is any habitation occupied by a 'household group' and may comprise the whole or only a part of a building.
- (b) A 'household group' is a person or group of persons living as a domestic unit with common eating arrangements.

The number of 'occupied dwellings' and the number of 'households' are therefore identical by definition.

The lack of a structural definition of a dwelling is not considered a significant disadvantage in Australia as the majority of households do in fact each occupy one distinct dwelling structure (i.e. a house or a self-contained flat).

Class of dwelling

Details of the numbers of each class of dwelling have been obtained from householders' statements made in accordance with the following instructions.

State below whether the dwelling is a—

- Private house (including semi-detached and terrace house).
 - * Share of a private house.
 - † Self-contained flat (including home unit).
 - * Share of a flat.
 - Room(s), apartment or flat (not self-contained).
 - Shed, hut, caravan, tent, boat, etc.
 - Licensed hotel, motel, hostel, boarding house, institution, barracks, staff quarters, etc.
 - * Where a private house or flat is shared without structural subdivision by two or more household groups each householder should fill in a separate Householder's Schedule.
- † 'Self-contained' means able to be completely closed off and with own cooking and bathing facilities.

Dwellings are classified as follows:

Private dwellings—private house

- share of private house
- self-contained flat
- share of self-contained flat
- shed, hut, tent, caravan, etc.
- other private dwellings

Non-private dwellings—licensed hotel

- motel
- boarding house
- educational institution
- religious institution
- charitable institution
- hospital
- staff barracks, etc.

Where the class of dwelling was 'not stated' a class was allocated prior to tabulation on the basis of other information in the census schedule or answers given for neighbouring dwellings.

Persons not enumerated in dwellings

Persons, who on census night were camping out, travelling on board ships in Australian waters, or ships which had left an Australian port prior to census night with a next port of call in Australia, or were enumerated on long-distance trains, motor coaches or aircraft, are not regarded as living in a dwelling for census purposes. Persons classified as 'camping out' include those living temporarily (e.g. on holidays) in tents, caravans or houseboats, or who were 'camped out' on census night. If a tent, caravan or houseboat constituted a semi-permanent dwelling it was classified as a dwelling and is included in Table 9 of this publication.

Number of inmates

The number of inmates of a dwelling relates to the number of persons actually enumerated in that dwelling (i.e. the number of persons who spent the night of 30 June 1966 in the dwelling) and does not include persons who normally reside at that dwelling but spent census night elsewhere.

Number of rooms

Each householder was asked to state the number of rooms in the dwelling in accordance with the following instructions.

State below the number of rooms in this dwelling. Count all rooms (including permanently enclosed sleep-out) **except** bathroom, toilet, pantry, laundry or storeroom.

Note: Rooms in non-attached buildings should be included only if used for living or sleeping purposes by members of this household. A combined living-dining room or combined kitchen-living or kitchen-dining room should be counted as one room.

A shared kitchen or shared living room in a shared house should be included only by the owner or principal tenant.

The specific instructions relating to non-attached buildings were included at the 1961 Census but those relating to combined-usage rooms were introduced at the 1966 Census.

Where the number of rooms in a dwelling was not stated, a number was allocated prior to tabulation on the basis of the answer given for the geographically nearest dwelling of the same class, except in the case of sheds, huts, tents, garages, caravans and houseboats where allocation was made by the use of a series of random numbers. The random numbers, which ranged from 1 to 8 rooms, were based upon the distribution of the number of rooms recorded in these types of dwellings at the 1961 Census.

The number of cases for which number of rooms was not stated is relatively small.
