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NOTES ON THE ESTIMATES

MAIN FEATURES

NOTE: Changes in individual quarters are necessarily subject to the uncertainties discussed in the Explanatory notes under interpretation of quarterly estimates, and furthermore some may be substantially revised as firmer data come to hand. This applies particularly to the estimates for the two most recent years for gross operating surplus, the income of companies and non-farm unincorporated enterprises, depreciation, and therefore to the estimated magnitude of change in gross non-farm product.

In current price seasonally adjusted terms, wages, salaries and supplements fell by 1.6 per cent in June quarter 1983, following a fall of 0.1 per cent in the previous quarter, while gross operating surplus of trading enterprise companies rose by 12.3 per cent after falling by 2.4 per cent in the March quarter 1983.

The following notes are provided to aid analysis of the estimates for recent quarters.

Wages, salaries and supplements

The seasonally adjusted movements in this aggregate for recent quarters should be interpreted cautiously in the light of the following discussion.

From December quarter 1981 an interim quarterly survey has been the principal source for compiling estimates of wages, salaries and supplements. Prior to that quarter the estimates were mainly based on payroll tax data. The employment coverage of the estimates has continued to be adjusted to reflect movements in the number of wage and salary earners shown in the monthly Labour Force Survey.

Since the estimates from the interim survey are based on information obtained from a sample of

employers, they are subject to sampling variability; that is, they may differ from the figures that would have been produced if all employers had been included in the survey.

A small pay periodicity survey was conducted in respect of September quarter 1981 in order to assist in estimating the effects of changes in the seasonal pattern between the payroll tax data underlying the series prior to December quarter 1981 and the Quarterly Survey of Earnings data underlying the series from December quarter 1981. Because of the limited nature of the data that was obtained, extra caution is required in interpreting the seasonally adjusted estimates for recent quarters.

An expanded survey of employers (covering approximately 20,000 employers) will commence in respect of

September quarter 1983. It is also planned to conduct another pay periodicity survey in respect of September quarter 1984. These developments should significantly improve the reliability of quarterly estimates of seasonally adjusted wages, salaries and supplements.

Gross operating surplus-companies

The gross operating surplus of companies is obtained by deducting the stock valuation adjustment (SVA) from an estimate of the profits of companies which, for the quarters of the latest year, are calculated using data obtained from the profits survey conducted by the ABS. During the past few quarters there have been some particularly erratic movements in the estimates of gross operating surplus of companies, caused by volatility in the SVA and the profits survey results. (The March and June quarter 1982 issues of this publication have contained details concerning the assumptions used in estimating the SVA and the way in which the SVA can be subject to quite large quarterly fluctuations.)

The SVA has not exhibited stable seasonality in the past and therefore is not seasonally adjusted. Gross operating surplus of companies is calculated in seasonally adjusted terms as the difference between the seasonally adjusted estimate of the profits of companies and the SVA (in original, or unadjusted, terms). There is some evidence that a seasonal pattern may be emerging in the SVA and, if this is the case, the seasonally adjusted estimates of gross operating surplus of companies calculated as described above may also move erratically because of the effects of residual seasonality in the estimates. For these reasons the changes in this aggregate in recent quarters should be interpreted with additional caution.

Government final consumption expenditure

The current price value of this aggregate is estimated using data from public authority accounts, which record cash flows. The estimates therefore reflect the effects of pre-payment of salaries over holiday periods, back pay associated with award changes, etc. It is not always possible to identify all these effects when compiling the deflators used to derive constant price estimates. Therefore, quarter-to-quarter movements in the constant price seasonally adjusted estimates for this aggregate should be treated with caution. The decline in this aggregate in constant price seasonally terms in the June quarter is partly attributable to the unusually high level of expenditure in March quarter 1983 when a frigate valued at \$174 million (at current prices) was delivered to the Australian Navy.

Stocks

A record decline was recorded for the third successive quarter in constant price seasonally adjusted private non-farm stocks. Despite the large run-downs in stocks that have occurred since September quarter 1982, the constant price private non-farm stocks to sales ratio of 0.743 in June quarter 1983 is still above the low of 0.719 recorded in September quarter 1973. The private non-farm stocks to sales(a) ratio in recent quarters is as follows:

(a) Constant price sales are defined as gross non-farm product *plus* imports (excluding petroleum, civil aircraft and government imports) *less* changes in private non-farm stocks. (All these variables are at average 1979-80 prices.)

Imports of goods and services

During the June quarter 1983, the seasonally adjusted volume of imports of goods and services grew for the first time in a year despite the devaluation of the Australian dollar in March 1983. The growth was mainly attributable to a strong rise in basic materials imports from the abnormally low level recorded in March quarter 1983 and some major deliveries of transport equipment. Excluding these deliveries, the machinery and equipment category continued to decline from the peak reached in June quarter 1982.

Between the March and June quarters 1983, the implicit price deflator (IPD) for non-fuel imports f.o.b. increased by over 5 per cent. It should be noted that problems inherent in constructing constant price series become particularly severe in circumstances such as the currency devaluation which occurred in March. Consequently, movements in the IPD of imports f.o.b. following a major devaluation should not be regarded as a reliable short-term guide to the rate at which large discrete changes in the exchange rate affect import prices.

Statistical discrepancy

The statistical discrepancy represents the difference between the sum of the estimates of gross domestic product (GDP) and imports of goods and services on the one hand and the sum of the estimates of components of gross national expenditure and exports of goods and services on the other hand. Conceptually these two totals are the same. The inclusion of the statistical discrepancy on the expenditure side of the domestic production account is a convention and does not necessarily imply that the sum of the income components more accurately measures GDP than the sum of the expenditure components.

The aspect of the statistical discrepancy which is of most concern in the quarterly context is the magnitude of change from one quarter to the next. In some quarters there are quite significant movements in the seasonally adjusted constant price statistical discrepancy. A useful way of examining the significance of the statistical discrepancy is to compare the change in gross non-farm product as published with the result which would be obtained using the expenditure aggregates excluding the statistical discrepancy. The following table shows such a comparison for the last 6 quarters.

Household saving ratio

Present estimates indicate that, on a seasonally adjusted basis, the proportion of household disposable income devoted to consumption in the June quarter was 87.6 per cent while household saving which is derived as a balancing item represented 12.4 per cent. Both of these ratios are affected by any deficiencies or inconsistencies in the estimation and seasonal adjustment of household income and expenditure.

The household saving ratio in recent quarters is as follows:

Implicit price deflators

The implicit price deflators (IPDs) for gross domestic product (GDP), gross non-farm product (GNFP) and gross national expenditure (GNE) have moved erratically in recent quarters and do not appear to be providing accurate short-term measures of price change. They are derived by dividing a seasonally adjusted current price value by the corresponding seasonally adjusted constant price value. The seasonal adjustment of current price GNFP is carried out by adjusting a number of income components and aggregating them, whereas in constant price terms GNFP is seasonally adjusted in total. As a result, it is possible for different seasonal patterns to be estimated for the current and constant price seasonally adjusted series and these will show up in the IPD. Since seasonally adjusted constant price estimates of GDP and GNE are dependent on seasonally adjusted GNFP any differences which may be in GNFP will also be carried through into these other two aggregates.

Revisions

Estimates for all aggregates have been revised in accordance with the annual estimates published in Budget Paper No. 10, *National Income and Expenditure, 1982-83* (5213.0). The major revisions to estimates of quarterly movements in 1982-83 were in respect of gross farm product in the September quarter; gross operating surplus of trading enterprise companies and gross non-farm product in the December quarter; and gross operating surplus of trading enterprise companies and private gross fixed capital expenditure on dwellings in the March quarter.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication provides estimates of the components of gross domestic product and national expenditure and supporting tables for the June quarter 1983, together with comparative estimates for the eight previous quarters and the four years 1979-80 to 1982-83. In addition, seasonally adjusted estimates of the major aggregates and some selected series are provided for the June quarter 1983, together with comparative estimates for the twelve previous quarters. Tables 32-42 provide time series, in both original and seasonally adjusted terms, for the period from September quarter 1969 for the aggregates contained in the domestic production account (at both current and average 1979-80 prices), some selected income aggregates and implicit price deflators.

Concepts, definitions, sources and methods

2. A basic guide to the Australian national accounts entitled *Australian National Accounts, Concepts, Sources and Methods* (5216.0) is available. It outlines major concepts and definitions, describes sources of data and methods used to derive annual and quarterly estimates for major aggregates at current and constant prices and discusses the accuracy and reliability of the national accounts. The concepts, definitions, sources and methods applicable to the estimates contained in this publication are as described in 5216.0 but with the changes outlined in Appendix A, *Australian National Accounts, National Income and Expenditure, 1981-82* (5204.0).

Interpretation of quarterly estimates

3. Estimating for a period of less than one year presents special problems in that it is often difficult to adhere strictly to definitions and concepts used in annual estimates. The measurement of income for a quarterly period is particularly difficult since it is not always possible to match the value of production for a quarter with the cost incurred in that production. This problem occurs, for example, in estimating the income of farm unincorporated enterprises in each quarter, and results in considerable variation of the estimates for this series, and for gross farm product, from quarter to quarter. Difficulties are also experienced in obtaining detailed data for short periods and in preparing consistent estimates from various sources where different accounting procedures and periods are used.

4. These problems inevitably affect the consistency and reliability of the current price estimates, and similarly affect the constant price estimates based on the current price estimates. Accordingly, these factors as well as the approximations and assumptions necessarily made in the revaluation of flows to constant prices should be borne in mind when interpreting or using the estimates for example, in attempting to draw precise quantitative inferences relating to quarter-to-quarter changes in gross domestic product or its components, or in productivity.

5. Analysis of trends requires allowance for these uncertainties in estimation. The effects are in some measure indicated by the change in the statistical discrepancy for corresponding periods. Uncertainty in trends arises also from the likelihood of revisions as more information becomes available and from the irregularity of short-term movements. The inclusion of the statistical discrepancy on the expenditure side of the accounts is a convention and does not necessarily imply that the sum of the income components more accurately measures GDP than the sum of the expenditure components (plus exports less imports). As household and other saving are estimated as balancing items in their respective accounts, care should be exercised in their interpretation.

6. Estimates of national income and expenditure are necessarily prepared from a wide range of statistical information, some of which is available quickly and some only with a delay of several years. For this reason most figures should be regarded as subject to revision as more complete and more accurate information becomes available. The revisions will be of two main types—those made to the most recent quarters as firmer quarterly or monthly data come to hand and those which are a consequence of revisions to annual totals and are distributed to the quarters approximately in accordance with existing quarterly patterns.

7. No simple measure is available of the accuracy of the major summary national accounting aggregates. However the following example illustrates the *sensitivity* of quarter to quarter growth to the timing of recording a transaction. If, in the latest year, the timing of recording a transaction were delayed by one quarter and if the transaction had an impact on constant price gross domestic product of +\$30 million then the measure of the rate of growth would be affected in three adjoining quarters (centred on the quarter in which the transaction was recorded) by -0.1, +0.2, and -0.1 percentage points respectively. Of course the percentage impact of such a timing delay on relevant sub-aggregates would be greater.

8. The quarterly implicit price deflators (IPDs) shown in Tables 9 and 42 are derived by dividing seasonally adjusted current price estimates by the corresponding seasonally adjusted constant price estimates. Movements in the levels of individual implicit price deflators can be greatly affected by changes in the physical composition of the aggregates and their components. Generally, it is considered that IPDs derived from seasonally adjusted data are more reliable than those obtained by using original (i.e. unadjusted) series, because the former are less likely to be affected by compositional change than are the latter. However the seasonal adjustment process is itself a source of possible distortion, especially to the extent that it is not possible to identify, in a fully

consistent way, the seasonality of the current price estimates and of the constant price estimates. A discussion of the limitations involved in using IPDs as measures of pure price change is contained in Appendix B of *Australian National Accounts, Concepts, Sources and Methods* (5216.0).

Seasonal adjustment

9. As most series are affected to some extent by seasonal factors, allowance should be made for normal seasonal variation. In Tables 6, 8, 9, 13, 17, 19, 22, 23, 33, 35 and 37 to 42, *seasonally adjusted* values are presented for selected series. Series which show substantial irregularities in the original or adjusted series should be treated with some reserve. As different methods of seasonal adjustment tend to produce different results, it is necessary to bear in mind the methods by which they have been derived and the limitations to which those methods are subject. It should also be noted that the methods of seasonal adjustment used by the ABS do not force the sum of the seasonally adjusted estimates for each quarter of a financial year to equal the original annual total.

10. The general methods used in the ABS for making seasonal adjustments are described in *Seasonally Adjusted Indicators, Australia, 1983* (1308.0). However, special methods have been used to adjust some of the components of gross farm product which were not amenable to seasonal adjustment by the usual methods. To obtain the seasonally adjusted estimates, the estimated values of production of wheat, other grain and sugar cane, for any financial year, are distributed equally over the four quarters of the year ended June. One effect of these methods is that changes in the annual production of these commodities first enter into the seasonally adjusted figures in the September quarter.

11. Where there is no apparent seasonality in their implicit price deflators, constant price estimates are seasonally adjusted using the same factors as are used for adjusting the corresponding current price estimates. As far as possible the remaining constant price estimates have been adjusted using methods similar to those for the corresponding current price estimates.

Analysis of contributions to growth table

12. Table 3 represents an analysis of the contribution provided by each major aggregate to the percentage

change in seasonally adjusted gross domestic product at constant prices. The formula used to calculate the contribution by each aggregate to the growth in GDP is:

$$\frac{A(t)-A(t-1)}{GDP(t-1)} \times 100.0$$

where $A(t)$ = value of aggregate A in quarter under consideration

$A(t-1)$ = value of aggregate A in preceding quarter

$GDP(t-1)$ = value of GDP in preceding quarter

All these values are seasonally adjusted constant price estimates. It should be noted that the figures in this table are additive within each quarter unlike the percentage change tables shown elsewhere in this publication.

Rounding of figures

13. Although percentage changes are given to one decimal place in this publication, this does not imply that they can be regarded as accurate to the last digit shown. The figures after the decimal point are given to avoid distortions which may occur in rounding off the figures to the nearest half or whole number.

14. The procedures used in preparing this publication may occasionally result in rounding differences between figures in this publication and corresponding figures in other publications.

15. Where figures have been rounded, discrepancies may occur between sums of the component items and totals.
