To enable CURF users greater flexibility in their analyses, the ABS has included two SEIFA and three sub-state geography items on the NHS expanded file. However, cross-tabulations by a pair of these items results in some small geographic regions which is likely to enable identification. While it would be expected that users cross-tabulate either the SEIFAs or the sub-state geographies in determining which to use in their analysis, it is not expected that more than one be used in detailed analyses. Output of analysis containing more than one SEIFA and/or more than one sub-state geography, in addition to other items, is not allowable.
