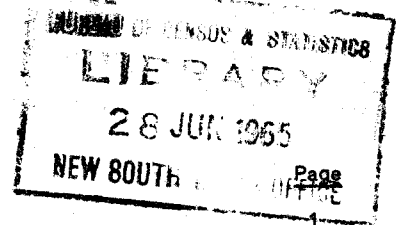

Explanatory Notes

This publication provides statistics of overseas arrivals and departures classified as permanent and long-term movement during the March quarter, 1965. Table 1, however, gives a short summary of all overseas arrivals and departures including those classified as short-term movement. More detailed statistics of short-term movement, and of total movement, will appear in Part 2 of this publication, to be entitled "Overseas Arrivals and Departures March Quarter, 1965. Part 2. - Total and Short-term Movement". These publications have previously constituted issues of the "Australian Demographic Review" series but will in future be issued as a separate series. The arrangement of the contents has not changed.

2. Statistics of country of birth of arrivals and departures classified as permanent and long-term movement, and of age and conjugal condition of permanent arrivals and departures, are prepared for six-monthly periods, the latest published being for the half-year ended December, 1964 in Australian Demographic Review No. 213, issued on 1st April, 1965. Preliminary monthly figures of overseas arrivals and departures, classified into permanent, long-term and short-term movements, are also issued, the latest being in respect of April, 1965; see Australian Demographic Review No. 219, issued on 28th May, 1965.

3. The classification into permanent, long-term and short-term is based on the purpose of travel stated by the traveller on arrival in or departure from Australia. THESE STATEMENTS REPRESENT THE TRAVELLER'S INTENTION AT THE TIME. MANY TRAVELLERS SUBSEQUENTLY CHANGE THEIR INTENTIONS AND THIS MUST BE BORNE IN MIND IN INTERPRETING THE STATISTICS.

4. Permanent movement consists of persons arriving with stated intent to settle permanently in Australia and Australian residents departing with stated intent to reside permanently abroad. Settlers are persons who, on arrival in Australia, indicated that they came intending to settle. Former Settlers (see column 5 of Table 2) are persons who, on departure from Australia, stated that they had come to Australia intending to settle, had stayed for a period of twelve months or more, and were now departing permanently. Persons who stayed less than twelve months are classified to "visitors departing, short-term movement".

5. Long-term movement consists of the arrival of visitors and the departure of residents with stated intent to stay (in Australia or in a country abroad, respectively) for twelve months or more and the departure of visitors and the return of Australians who have stayed (in Australia or in a country abroad, respectively) for twelve months or more.

6. Short-term movement consists of all other movements, including the movement of Australian troops, irrespective of period of stay. However the statistics do not include persons passing through Australia without change of ship or aircraft. These passengers are not included in Australian statistics of arrivals and departures. Persons on a short pleasure cruise commencing and finishing in Australia on a ship not engaged in a regular voyage and air crew and ships' crew are also excluded.

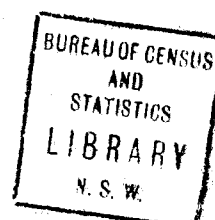
