OVERVIEW

INTRODUCTION

This paper provides information about the release of microdata from the Indigenous component of the 2001 National Health Survey (NHS(I)) and data from non-Indigenous respondents in the main sample of the 2001 National Health Survey (NHS).

The data are available through a Confidentialised Unit Record File (CURF) released with the approval of the Australian Statistician. The CURF is only available through the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) Remote Access Data Laboratory (RADL), and in the format of an Expanded CURF. There will be no Basic version available on CD-ROM or via the RADL. The RADL is an online database query system under which microdata are held on a server at the ABS, to which users can submit programs to interrogate, analyse and model the data, and access their results. Microdata from the main NHS has been released in both Basic and Expanded versions, information for which can be found in *Information Paper: National Health Survey — Confidentialised Unit Record Files, 2001* (cat. no. 4324.0), and on the 'Access to ABS CURFs' pages on the ABS web site.

A full list of items contained on the 2001 NHS(I) CURF is provided as Appendix 1.

More detailed information to assist in using the CURF and in interpreting the data is provided in the *National Health Survey: Users' Guide — Electronic Publication* (cat. no. 4363.0.55.001) available on the ABS web site. It is recommended that relevant parts of the Guide be read in conjunction with use of this CURF.

ABOUT THE SURVEY

The 2001 NHS is the fifth health survey of its type conducted by the ABS. The 2001 NHS(I) is the second ABS health survey for which Indigenous estimates are available. The previous release of Indigenous data was from the 1995 NHS. However, the 2001 NHS(I) release will be the first time Indigenous health data are available through a CURF.

The Indigenous component of the 2001 NHS was conducted by the ABS via a supplementary sample of 1,647 private dwellings with Indigenous residents. Both urban and rural areas in all states and territories were covered, including sparsely settled areas. Non-private dwellings, such as hotels, motels, hospitals, nursing and convalescent homes and short-stay caravan parks were not included in the survey. In addition to this supplementary sample, Indigenous people from a further 290 private dwellings were enumerated in the main sample of the 2001 NHS, and these people contribute towards the total Indigenous population contained in the NHS(I).

Within each selected household, a random sub-sample of usual residents was selected for inclusion in the survey as shown below.

Households selected in non-sparsely settled areas of the Indigenous supplement comprised:

- one adult (aged 18 years and over)
- up to two children aged 0–17 years.

Households selected in sparsely settled areas of the Indigenous supplement comprised:

- one adult (aged 18 years and over)
- up to one child aged 0–17 years.

Households selected in the National Health Survey main sample comprised:

- one adult (aged 18 years and over)
- all children aged 0–6 years
- up to one child aged 7–17 years.

Trained ABS interviewers conducted personal interviews with selected residents of the sampled private dwellings. One person aged 18 years and over in each dwelling was selected and interviewed about their own health. An adult resident, nominated by the household, was interviewed about the health of each child selected within the dwelling (children aged 15–17 years were personally interviewed where permission from parents or guardians was obtained). This person is called the child proxy. Adult female respondents were invited to complete a small additional questionnaire covering supplementary women's health topics.

The survey collected information about:

- the health status of the population, including long-term medical conditions experienced and recent injuries
- use of health services such as consultations with doctors and dentists, visits to hospital and other actions people have recently taken for their health
- health-related aspects of people's lifestyle, such as smoking, exercise and alcohol consumption
- demographic and socioeconomic characteristics.

Summary results from the 2001 NHS(I) were published in *National Health Survey: Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Results, Australia, 2001* (cat. no. 4715.0) released in November 2002. More extensive analysis of Indigenous results were published in *The Health and Welfare of Australia's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples, 2003* (cat. no. 4704.0) released in August 2003. Summary results from the 2001 NHS were published in *National Health Survey: Summary of Results, 2001* (cat. no. 4364.0) released in October 2002. Results relating to specific topics covered by the survey have been released during 2003 with further topic-specific publications planned for release during 2004, details of which will be posted on <<http://www.abs.gov.au>>.

Users will find on the ABS web site copies of the questionnaires used in the 2001 NHS and NHS(I), a list of all data items available from the survey (not all of which are included on the CURF), and the NHS Users' Guide which contains detailed information about the survey design and operation, survey content, and data quality and interpretation for both the NHS and NHS(I). ABOUT THE MICRODATA

The NHS(I) CURF contains 30,060 confidentialised respondent records, comprising 3,681 Indigenous records and 26,379 non-Indigenous records.

The NHS(I) and non-Indigenous NHS microdata are released under the *Census and Statistics Act 1905* which has provision for the release of data in the form of unit records where the information is not likely to enable the identification of a particular person or organisation. Accordingly, there are no names or addresses of survey respondents on the CURF, and other steps have been taken to protect the confidentiality of respondents' information. These other steps include the exclusion of some items from the CURF, not including the full level of detail collected for some items, and swapping some

characteristics between records (to mask individual combinations of characteristics without limiting the usefulness of the data for analysis).

Steps to confidentialise the data made available on the CURF are taken in such a way as to ensure the integrity of the dataset and optimise its content, while maintaining the confidentiality of respondents. Data quality issues have also been considered in the determination of what data items will be released on this CURF. Intending purchasers of the NHS(I) RADL service should ensure that the level of detail they require is available on the CURF. Data obtained in the survey but not contained on the CURF may be available in tabulated form on request. A full list of data items included on the CURF is provided in Appendix 1.

Data content for the NHS(I) CURF is similar to that of the NHS Expanded CURF. However, due to the smaller size of the Indigenous sample, some data items on the NHS(I) CURF contain lesser levels of detail than for the same items on the NHS Expanded CURF. For some items, where the quality of the Indigenous data can support greater levels of detail, more detailed items than those on the NHS Expanded CURF are provided. However, data for non-Indigenous respondents have been limited to that available on the NHS Expanded CURF. For example, 'Number of persons in household' (NPER) is top-coded at ten or more for Indigenous households, while results for non-Indigenous households remain top-coded at six or more.

The level of detail of some items provided on the NHS(I) CURF differs for persons in remote areas compared to non-remote areas. The content included in the questionnaire used in remote areas was approximately 50% of that used in non-remote areas. Data items not collected in remote areas are indicated in Appendix 1. Note, that for confidentiality reasons, remoteness is not included on the CURF as a classificatory variable for the non-Indigenous population.

Data items for which less detail was collected in remote areas are presented using two formats:

- The first format preserves the full detail of the data item but is available only for the non-remote Indigenous population and the non-Indigenous population. This version provides the maximum number of categories available for release and is indicated by '(Expanded)' at the end of the data item title.
- The second format involves collapsing the data item categories to the level of detail supported by the remote data. This format supports comparative analysis across all population groups, including the remote and non-remote Indigenous populations and the non-Indigenous population. It should also be used to obtain data for the total Indigenous population. This version is indicated by '(Total)' at the end of the data item title.

For example, the data item 'Type of medical contact' is presented in both formats; the 'Total' version which is released with 10 categories (remote and non-remote Indigenous population and non-Indigenous population), and the 'Expanded' version with 14 categories (non-remote Indigenous population and non-Indigenous population). Each version has a different SAS name in the data item list (see Appendix 1).

ESTIMATION

As the survey was conducted on a stratified sample of households, it is important to take account of the weights applying to each record (person) when deriving estimates from the CURF. A 'main weight' is provided for each person on the NHS(I) CURF to allow users to do this. This weight is a value which indicates the number of people in the population represented by the person. The weight is provided in a nine character field, presenting the weight to four decimal places.

Where estimates are derived from the CURF they should be calculated by adding the weights of persons in each category rather than simply by counting the number of records falling into each category. Note that each person's 'weight' not only takes account of a person's chance of selection but also different response rates across population groups. The application of weights ensures that estimates conform to an independently estimated distribution of the population by age, sex, state/territory and section of state, rather than to the distributions within the sample itself.

For weighting purposes, the 2001 NHS(I) was benchmarked to the estimated resident Indigenous population living in private dwellings at 30 June 2001 based on results from the 2001 Census of Population and Housing. The 2001 NHS was also benchmarked in a similar way but related to the total resident population living in private dwellings at 30 June 2001.

Users of the NHS(I) CURF should note that total Australia estimates produced by aggregating NHS(I) and non-Indigenous NHS records will not match national figures published in the *National Health Survey: Summary of Results, 2001* (cat. no. 4364.0) and do not reflect accurate total Australia estimates. The NHS Basic or Expanded CURFs should be used to obtain total Australia estimates.

AGE STANDARDISATION

The age structure of the Indigenous population is considerably younger than that of the non-Indigenous population. As age is strongly related to health, statistical comparisons between Australia's Indigenous and non-Indigenous populations which do not take account of age may be misleading. Age standardisation is recommended by the ABS to improve the validity of comparisons between Indigenous and Non-Indigenous populations when analysing health data.

Age-standardised (A-S) weights, produced using the 'direct' A-S method, have been provided on this file to assist users in compensating for the effect of the differing age structures. The age-standardised rate calculated using these weights are those which would have prevailed had the Indigenous and non-Indigenous populations had the same age composition as the standard population. The standard population used in creating these weights was the total Australian population at 30 June 2001 based on the 2001 Census of Population and Housing, adjusted for the scope of the survey.

Three types of age-standardised weights are provided on the NHS(I) CURF:

- A-S Sex weight — separately standardises estimates for Indigenous and non-Indigenous males/females using the total Australia population age structure as the standard population.
- A-S Total weight — separately standardises total Indigenous/non-Indigenous estimates to the total Australian population age structure.

- A-S Remote weight — for Indigenous estimates only. Separately standardises estimates for persons in remote/non-remote areas to the total Australian population age structure.

Note: age standardised data should be presented as rates (%) as the numbers ('000) produced are not meaningful.

For further details regarding age-standardised weights and the method used to produce the weights, please refer to Chapter 7 of the *National Health Survey: Users' Guide — Electronic Publication* (cat. no. 4363.0.55.001).

SAMPLING ERROR

Sampling error is the difference between the survey based estimate and the value that would have been produced had all dwellings of the in scope population been included.

In addition to the 'main weight' and age standardised weights each record on the CURFs contains 30 'replicate weights' for each weight. The purpose of these replicate weights is to enable calculation of the sampling error on each estimate produced.

The replication approach selects subsamples repeatedly (30 times) from the whole sample. For each of these subsamples the statistic of interest is calculated. The variance of the full sample statistics is then estimated using the variability among the replicate statistics calculated from these subsamples. The formula which has been used by ABS in calculating the Standard Errors (SEs) of estimates using the replicate weights technique is shown below:

- V1 is the main weight for persons (WEIGHTP)
- V2-V31 are the 30 replicate weights (REPWGT1 - 30).

As well as enabling variances of estimates to be calculated relatively simply, replicate weights also enable unit record analyses such as chi-square and logistic regression to be conducted which take into account the sample design.

Further information about the use of replicate weights is contained in the *National Health Survey: Users' Guide — Electronic Publication* (cat. no. 4363.0.55.001). It should be noted that not all statistical computer packages may allow direct calculation of SEs using replicate weights. However, those packages that allow the direct use of Balanced Repeated Replication (BRR) methodology generally include the option of an adjustment factor. This factor can be incorporated to overcome the difference between the variance formulae.

ABOUT THE DATA

Detailed information about data collected in the survey, comments regarding data quality and other points to assist in interpreting the data are contained in the *National Health Survey: Users' Guide — Electronic Publication* (cat. no. 4363.0.55.001).

In addition, the following points regarding the data appearing on this CURF should be noted.

- Adjustments have been made to the data in a small number of records in the course of confidentialising records included on the CURFs. For the Indigenous population these changes involve:
 - changing age groups
 - changing occupation, industry or industry sector groups
 - changing breastfeeding time periods.
- Adjustments made on the NHS CURFs for non-Indigenous records have also been applied to this file and involve:
 - changing income groupings
 - swapping weights between some records
 - changing height and/or weight values.
- Some amendments have been made to the NHS and the NHS(I) data files since the release of the summary publications, and some further minor changes (e.g. in rounding) have arisen due to slightly different ways of producing CURF data compared to producing publication estimates.
- While each of the above changes has been minor, collectively they mean that:
 - estimates produced from the CURF may differ by a small amount from those published in *National Health Survey: Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Results, Australia, 2001* (cat. no. 4715.0) or *National Health Survey: Summary of Results, 2001* (cat. no. 4364.0), or released in companion tables available electronically through the ABS web site.
- The nature of the changes made, and the relatively small number of records involved have ensured that the effects on the data for analysis purposes are considered negligible.
- Some data items on the CURFs directly reflect responses to individual questions contained in the survey questionnaire, while others have been derived from responses to two or more questions. Due to the volume and complexity of the derivations, these derivations are not generally released. However, details may be available on request.
- In previous NHSs, all persons in selected dwellings were enumerated, enabling users of the CURF to group people to form complete households, families and income units, and to analyse data in respect of those units. However, in the 2001 NHS and NHS(I) only one adult and selected children were included in the survey. As a result, only single person households and some single adult households with children were fully enumerated. Linkages are provided on the CURFs to enable child records from a household to be analysed together with the adult record from that household. However, as these household units are incomplete in most cases, analysis of the 2001 file on this CURF can generally only be done at the person level. Household, family and income unit characteristics are held on person records enabling analysis using these characteristics.

ABOUT THE FILES

The NHS(I) CURF is available only as an Expanded version through the Remote Access Data Laboratory (RADL). There will be no Basic version to access via the RADL or on CD-ROM. This Expanded RADL file can only be accessed in SAS and SPSS at this time. Additional software may be introduced in the future.

ABOUT THE FILES <i>continued</i>	The RADL provides access to a SAS and SPSS dataset and test files and frequency and weighting report for client validation purposes. Test files can be downloaded by clients to check their batch file syntax prior to submission on the RADL. A copy of this information paper will also be available from the ABS web site under 'List of Available CURFs'. Details of the SAS and SPSS files are shown in Appendix 2.
