Provides a detailed picture of Australia's exporting businesses and how they compare with non-exporting businesses. It also describes their impact on various aspects of the labour market and provides information on how exporting businesses are using computers and the Internet.

4436.0 *Caring in the Community, Australia, 1998* (\$22.00)

Providing information on informal carers from the 1998 Survey of Disability, Ageing and Carers, this publication is valuable for researchers in the fields of caring, disability and related community services. Topics included are need for, receipt and provision of assistance because of disability; characteristics of carers, and in particular primary carers; activities for which care is provided; the effects of caring on labour force experience and other aspects of the lives of primary carers; and the availability and use of support.

1350.0.65.001 *Experimental Composite Leading Indicator Time Series Data—on AUSSTATS, June Quarter 2000*

The Experimental Composite Leading Indicator (XCLI) is a single time series designed to provide early signals of turning points in the Australian business cycle.

The XCLI has been developed to supplement rather than to compete with existing forms of economic analysis and forecasting. It is updated each quarter, the results of which are reported each quarter in of the Australian Economic Indicators.
