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INTRODUCTION

INTRODUCTION

The Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) presents statistics on Australia's System of National Accounts which are compiled in accordance with international standards. These international standards were updated recently.

This paper focuses on the product *Australian System of National Accounts* (cat. no. 5204.0) and describes:

- the main changes to the international standards;
- the timing for implementing the changes in Australian statistics;
- the impact on the presentation of statistics in the product; and
- the structural impact on time series spreadsheets in the product.

This first issue of *Australian System of National Accounts* (cat. no. 5204.0) that will incorporate these updated standards will be 2008–09, scheduled for release on Tuesday 8 December 2009.

This information paper includes previews of the publication (pdf) tables and time series spreadsheets that will be published in December.

Details of impacts of these updated standards will be covered in a further Information paper, *Implementation of new international statistical standards in ABS National and International Accounts* (cat no. 5310.0.55.002) due for release on 30 September 2009.

CHANGES TO INTERNATIONAL STANDARDS

INTERNATIONAL FRAMEWORK

The international framework for economic statistics is centred around two key documents, the System of National Accounts, 1993 (SNA93) and the fifth edition of the Balance of Payments Manual (BPM5), both of which were released in 1993. Since the release of these key standards, a number of new economic phenomena has arisen or assumed greater importance as economies continue to develop in their complexity. In response to this, relevant international organisations and a range of national statistical agencies, including the ABS, have reviewed a range of conceptual and measurement issues that were either not clarified completely at the time of the release of SNA93 and BPM5, or have emerged as important measurement issues since that time. These issues are described in the Information Paper: Introduction of revised international standards in ABS economic statistics in 2009, 2007 (cat. no. 5310.0.55.001) released 6 September 2007.

The international standards for national and international accounts were updated concurrently and the standards are compatible. The new standards are presented in the System of National Accounts, 2008 (SNA08) and the Balance of Payments and International Investment Position Manual, sixth edition (BPM6).

The other major changes to the Australian System of National Accounts (ASNA) are due to the implementation of the Australian and New Zealand Standard Industrial Classification, 2006 (ANZSIC06) and changes brought about to the Standard Economic Sector Classification of Australia, 2008 (SESCA08).

The revised international standards have changed the measurement of a number of components of the ASNA, though there has been no major change to the structure of the accounts. The main changes are:

- Introduction of Research and Development as capital formation;
- Capitalisation of Expenditure on Defence Weapons Platforms; and
- The inclusion of reinvested earnings of investment funds.

A number of other changes are included and will be mentioned later in this paper. There are a number of changes stated in the SNA08 that the ABS is not implementing. These are:

- Basic Prices defined according to the System of National Accounts, 1968 (SNA68) concepts will continue to be applied through the Input-Output tables. The ABS intends to move to the SNA68 definition throughout other economic outputs over the coming years, as described in the Information Paper: *Introduction of revised international standards in ABS economic statistics in 2009, 2007* (cat. no. 5310.0.55.001).
- Repurchase Agreements where the ABS will continue to treat repurchase agreements as security trades rather than the treatment continued in the standards, which is as a loan.
- Recording of Interest on Debt Securities where the ABS will continue to measure interest in accordance with the creditor principle (interest flows are calculated with reference to market yields on the market value of the debt securities in question) and not the treatment continued in the standards, the debtor principle (interest flows calculated with reference to contractual or "coupon" rates on the nominal value of the debt securities in question).

- Ancillary Units (Holding Companies) where the ABS is proposing to maintain its current practice, which is in line with the spirit of the recommendations but deviates in the treatment of holding companies.
- Financial Instrument Classification where there are no plans to compile separate markets for shares and units. This detail is largely covered (implicitly) by the changes to the sectoral classifications within SESCA08.
- Reclassifications for Transactions between non-residents, as the ABS considers that by issuing a tradeable instrument, the issuer is implicitly a counterparty to any secondary trading in the instrument and that a transaction should be recorded between the vendor and the issuer extinguishing the position, and a second transaction between the purchaser and the issuer creating the position. The ABS will therefore not treat the exchange as a reclassification.

Investigation is continuing into the estimation of capital services for assets owned by the General Government sector. The results of the investigation will be published in an information paper and potentially included in the accounts, initially as a memorandum item.

More information on these areas of non-compliance can be found in the introductory Information paper: *Introduction of revised international standards in ABS economic statistics in 2009, 2007* (cat. no. 5310.0.55.001).

In addition, the ABS will incorporate the results of a number of changes that were not included from SNA93 implementation in 1998, including:

- implementation of orchard growth in the capital and production accounts which is generally included in the category 'Cultivated biological resources'; and
- moving Financial Auxiliaries to the financial sector.

The ABS is incorporating changes arising from SNA into Australian Standards and Classifications. The changes to SNA08 have introduced some new elements to the Standard Economic Sector Classification for Australia, 2008 (SESCA08). The change is mainly from the introduction of Money Market Funds and Non-Money Market Funds in the Standard Institutional Sector Classification for Australia (SISCA08). KEY CHANGES TO OUTPUTS

KEY CHANGES TO OUTPUTS

Backcasting.

System of National Accounts, 2008

From the 2008–09 issue of *Australian System of National Accounts* (cat. no. 5204.0), data will be presented on a SNA08, BPM6, ANZSIC06 and SESCA08 basis. The changes being implemented with these new standards will impact on the value of some key aggregates. However, data quality improvements will result in a shift in the level of some series. To maintain the integrity of time series, level shifts will be backcast to the same start dates as previously published.

GROSS FIXED CAPITAL FORMATION (GFCF)

Significant changes to the private gross fixed capital formation component of Expenditure on Gross Domestic Product are:

- 'Cultivated biological resources', which replaces the previously published 'Livestock' but includes a new component of 'Orchard growth'; and
- 'Intellectual property products', which replaces the previously published 'Intangible fixed assets' but includes a new component of 'Research and development'.

The order in which the various private sector assets are displayed has also changed to better align with SNA08. This has also meant that the category of 'Private business investment' has been dropped from the pdf tables, but has been retained in the time series spreadsheets.

These changes to 'assets' also impact on the labelling and ordering of assets in the balance sheets.

Affected tables are:

CAPITALISATION OF WEAPONS SYSTEMS

The treatment of defence expenditure has altered to bring it into line with capital formation in other industries. Expenditure on weapons systems that have an anticipated ongoing use (greater than one year) is recorded as gross fixed capital formation. Expenditure on 'disposable' equipment will continue to be recorded as inventories until used.

CAPITALISATION OF WEAPONS SYSTEMS continued

These changes will not affect the structure of the 'Expenditure on GDP' tables, but the levels of the following series will be impacted:

- Final consumption expenditure of:
 - National General Government-Defence and National General Government;
- Gross fixed capital formation of:
 - National General Government-Defence and National General Government.

TANGIBLE AND INTANGIBLE ASSETS

The delineation of produced non-financial assets into tangible and intangible has been removed from the balance sheets.

Affected tables are:

For non-produced assets, a new delineation has been introduced of:

- natural resources; and
- permissions to use natural resources.

REINVESTED EARNINGS

The imputation of reinvested earnings from undistributed direct foreign investment has been expanded to include undistributed earnings in both resident and non-resident investment funds.

OWNERSHIP TRANSFER COSTS

These costs, which were previously written off through consumption of fixed capital in the same period in which they arose, will now be written off over the period during which the acquirer expects to hold the asset.

Affected tables are:

pdf tables 16 to 19. 30 and time series spreadsheets 10, 20, 41 and 59, relating to 'balance sheets'.

MINERAL AND PETROLEUM EXPLORATION

Mineral exploration assets, previously considered to have already been implicitly included within the value of subsoil assets, will now be separately shown in the balance sheets and not implicitly included in subsoil assets.

CHANGES IN INVENTORIES

No longer publishing the item:

selected marketing authorities

More generally, private non-farm inventories includes, for all periods, privatised marketing authorities.

AGRICULTURAL INCOME

No longer publishing the items:

- Increase in assets with marketing authorities;
- Output for own consumption; and
- Realised agricultural income.

Australian and New Zealand Industrial Classification, 2006 A joint project between the ABS and Statistics New Zealand has developed a new standard classification of industrial activity, the Australian and New Zealand Standard Industrial Classification, 2006 (ANZSIC06). This will replace the existing classification, ANZSIC93, with a more contemporary classification system. This new classification is in response to changes in the structure and composition of the economy, changing user demands, and enhancing compatibility with other major international classification standards. The result of implementing this new classification is a significant change to the layout of industry representation in the Australian System of National Accounts. In particular these changes have brought about:

 changes to the ANZSIC06 division structure which will include 19 divisions compared to 17 in ANZSIC93;

- adaptation to the emergence of 'new economic' activities including internet publishing and broadcasting, computer retailing and communication equipment manufacturing;
- an introduction of a new industry division, 'Information Media and Telecommunications'. This new division groups activity mainly engaged in creating and storing information products in media that allow for their dissemination. This is an industry that has grown rapidly in both Australian and New Zealand since ANZSIC93 was developed;
- the splitting of 'Property and Business Services' division to its component parts of:
 - Rental, Hiring and Real Estate Services;
 - Professional, Scientific and Technical Services; and
 - Administrative and Support Services.

DEFINITION OF MARKET SECTOR

With the introduction of ANZSIC06, the definition of those industries that constitute the 'market sector' has also changed. It is now defined to include all industries, except:

- Public administration and safety (O);
- Education and training (P); and
- Health care and social assistance (Q).

Affected tables are:

- time series spreadsheet 1 and 30, relating to 'key aggregates and analytical series'.

The multifactor productivity estimates will continue to be produced, but on the basis of selected ANZSIC06 industries and not the new definition of market sector, Those ANZSIC06 industries excluded from the multifactor productivity estimates are:

- Rental, hiring and real estate services (L);
- Professional, scientific and technical services (M);
- Administrative and support services (N);
- Public administration and safety (O);
- Education and training (P); and

DEFINITION OF MARKET SECTOR continued

Other services (S).

Affected tables are:

Product consistency

In considering impacts of the revised international standards, some other changes have been made to the time series spreadsheets to improve the consistency of the treatment of some statistics.

USE OF GOVERNMENT PURPOSE CLASSIFICATION

Detailed breakdowns of Government final consumption expenditure and General Government gross fixed capital formation are classified by the Government Purpose Classification (GPC), which is also used in Government Finance statistics.

Affected tables are:

The current version of this product reflects SNA93 concepts and a number of references to data sources and methods are, or will be, out of date.

A revised Concepts, Sources and Methods product is scheduled for release in late 2010.
