NOTES

ABOUT THIS PUBLICATION

This publication contains preliminary estimates of the resident population by age (in five-year age groupings) and sex for each Statistical Local Area (SLA), Statistical Subdivision (SSD) and Statistical Division (SD) in South Australia at June 2000.

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FINAL ISSUE

This is the final issue of *Population by Age and Sex, South Australia* (Cat. no. 3235.4). In future years the age-sex data will be made available electronically in a SuperTABLE dataset or as companion data in Ausstats. Data at all levels within the Australian Standard Geographical Classification main structure will be included, as well as Local Government Areas. The new companion data will also effectively replace *Estimated Resident Population by Age and Sex in Statistical Local Areas, South Australia: Data on Floppy Disk* (Cat. no. 3227.4).

MAIN FEATURES

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SOUTH AUSTRALIA

South Australia's estimated resident population at June 2000 was 1,497,600, an increase of 5,200 (0.4%) since 1999, and 28,200 (1.9%) since 1995. Nationally, the rate of growth of the population between 1999 and 2000 was 1.2%.


The population of the Adelaide Statistical Division (SD) was 1,096,100 or 73.2% of the total population for the State, an increase of 3,700 persons (0.3%) over the 1999 figure. Since 1995, the population of the Adelaide SD had increased by 21,400 persons (2.0%).

As at June 2000, the median age of the South Australian population, that is the age at which half the population is older and half is younger, was 37.1 years. This was 1.9 years above the national median age of 35.2 years and makes the population of South Australia the oldest of all the States and Territories.

POPULATION DISTRIBUTION

The population pyramid below compares the distributions of the South Australian and Australian populations as at June 2000. As has been the case historically, South Australia continues to have a lower proportion of children and a higher proportion of elderly than the Australian population.

CHILDREN (UNDER 15 YEARS)

As at June 2000, there were 3.9 million children in Australia accounting for 20.5% of the population. In South Australia the number of children in 2000 was 291,500, a decrease of 2,600 (-0.9%) since 1999. The proportion of the State's population aged under 15 years has continued to decline. Children represented 20.4% of the State's population in 1995, 19.7% in 1999 and 19.5% in 2000.

The Adelaide SD continued to have the lowest proportion of children (18.5%) of all statistical divisions in South Australia. The SLAs with the lowest proportion of children within the Adelaide SD were Adelaide (5.4%) and Holdfast Bay—North (12.1%), while Playford—West Central (28.0%) was the SLA with the highest proportion of children followed by Salisbury—Inner North and Playford —East Central both with 27.1%.

The Eyre SD (23.2%) replaced the Northern SD (23.1%) as the SD with the highest proportion of children in the resident population. Outside the Adelaide SD, the SLA of Roxby Downs (30.6%) had the highest proportion of children, while Victor Harbor (16.1%) had the lowest.

THE AGED (65 YEARS AND OVER)

At the National level, the proportions of the population aged 65 years and over in 2000, 1999 and 1995 were 12.3%, 12.3% and 11.9% respectively. In South Australia there were 216,700 aged persons resident in the population in 2000, an increase of 2,400 persons (1.1%) since 1999 and 13,700 persons (6.7%) since 1995. The size of South Australia's aged population is increasing at almost three times the rate of the population as a whole. Persons aged 65 years and over constituted 14.5% of the South Australian population in 2000, compared to 14.4% in 1999 and 13.8% in 1995. Of the State's aged population, 24,400 (11.3%) were aged 85 years and over.

Persons aged 65 years or more accounted for 14.5% of the Adelaide SD population. Within the Adelaide SD, the SLAs with the lowest proportions of person aged 65 years and over were Tea Tree Gully—North (5.2%) and Salisbury—Inner North (5.6%). The SLAs with the highest proportions of persons aged 65 years and over within the Adelaide SD were Holdfast Bay—South (25.5%) and Holdfast Bay—North (24.4%).

The Yorke and Lower North SD (19.2%) had the highest proportion of aged persons of all statistical divisions in South Australia. Outside the Adelaide SD, the SLA of Roxby Downs (1.2%) had the lowest proportion of persons aged 65 and over, while Victor Harbor (29.4%) had the highest.

SEX RATIO

At June 2000 the overall sex ratio (number of males per 100 females) of the Australian population was 99.2, up from 99.1 in 1999. In South Australia there were 740,600 males and 757,000 females resident in the population resulting in a more female dominant sex ratio of 97.8. In 1999, the sex ratio for the State was also 97.8, while in 1995 it was 97.9. Females outnumber males in the Adelaide SD (sex ratio 96.1), whilst the remainder of the State has more males than females (sex ratio 102.7).

In South Australia, male children outnumber female children, with the sex ratio in 2000 being 105.1. The sex ratio for children has remained fairly stable since 1995. In the older age group, females continue to outnumber males. In 2000, the sex ratio for the population aged 65 years and over was 77.0, compared with 76.8 in 1999 and 75.8 in 1995.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

INTRODUCTION

- 1** This publication contains preliminary estimates of the resident population by age and sex in statistical local areas (SLAs) in South Australia at 30 June 2000.
- 2** The estimated resident population (ERP) is the official ABS estimate of the Australian population.

METHODOLOGY

- 3** The total population of each SLA is based on results of the 1996 Population Census and calculated for post-census dates by a linear regression model which uses independent indicators of population change such as dwelling approvals, licensed drivers and medicare enrolments. These intercensal estimates of the resident population are revised each time a population census is taken.
- 4** The age and sex estimates were prepared using the cohort component method. Post-censal age distributions were obtained by advancing the age and sex estimates for 30 June 1996 to the next age, subtracting deaths and adding births and net estimated inter-regional and overseas migration. Inter-regional and overseas migration was estimated from analysis of arrivals and departures data and individual SLA profiles derived from the 1996 Census. More details can be provided by the ABS South Australian Office.
- 5** After each Census final estimates for the preceding intercensal period are calculated by incorporating an additional adjustment (intercensal discrepancy) to ensure that the total intercensal increase at each age agrees with the difference between the estimated resident population at the two respective census dates.
- 6** A detailed explanation of the concept of estimated resident population, as adopted by the ABS for official population estimates, is contained in the ABS Information Paper: *Population Estimates: Concepts, Sources and Methods* (Cat. no. 3228.0).

GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES

- 7** The geographic areas used in this publication are defined in the *Australian Standard Geographical Classification, 2000 Edition* (Cat. no. 1216.0).

RELIABILITY

- 8** All SLA estimates are shown to the nearest person, although accuracy to this level is not claimed and should not be assumed.
