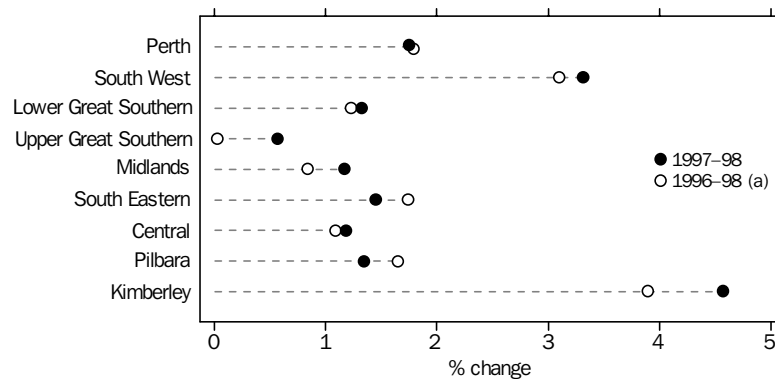
SUMMARY

The Estimated Resident Population of Western Australia at 30 June 1998 was 1,831,399, representing an increase of 33,529 persons or 1.9% since 30 June 1997.

The proportion of the State population residing in the Perth Statistical Division has changed very little since 1991, the comparable figures being 72.7% at 30 June 1991, 73.4% at 30 June 1996 and 73.3% at 30 June 1998.

The South West Statistical Division had the second highest Estimated Resident Population after the Perth Statistical Division, followed by the Central and the South Eastern Statistical Divisions.

POPULATION, Rate of Growth — Statistical Divisions

The South West Statistical Division continued to grow strongly, increasing by 5,705 persons (3.3%) since 30 June 1997. In percentage terms, this increase was exceeded only by Kimberley Statistical Division which grew by 4.6% (1,211 persons).

Growth continued in all the remaining Statistical Divisions, ranging from 0.6% in the Upper Great Southern to 1.5% in the South Eastern Statistical Division.

PERTH STATISTICAL DIVISION

Between 30 June 1997 and 30 June 1998, the Estimated Resident Population of the Perth Statistical Division increased by 23,133 persons (1.8%) to 1,341,914.

Most Statistical Local Areas in the Perth Statistical Division had population increases, the exceptions being Perth City – Inner and Vincent which recorded small losses. The population increases in other Statistical Local Areas ranged from 0.3% (6 persons) in Peppermint Grove to 8.2% (1,631 persons) in Wanneroo – North-West.

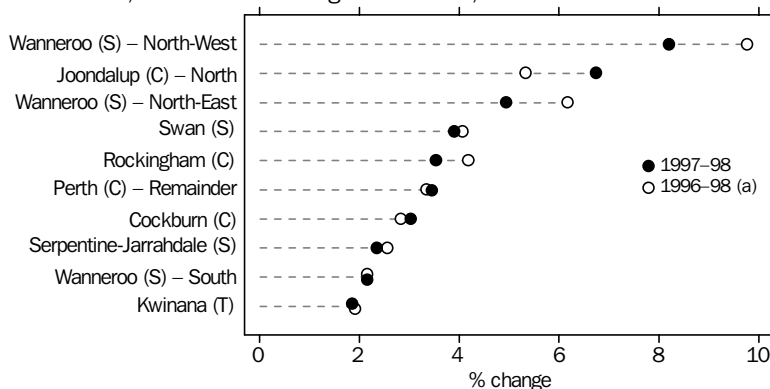
Growth continued strongest along the north west "population corridor", particularly in the Statistical Local Areas of Joondalup – North (6.8%), Wanneroo – North-West (8.2%) and Wanneroo – North-East (4.9%). Growth was also strong in Swan (3.9%) in the north east "corridor" and in Rockingham (3.6%) and Cockburn (3.0%) in the south west "corridor".

As in the previous year, Swan had the largest increase (2,904 persons), bringing its total population to 77,453. This was followed by Joondalup – North where the population rose by 2,728 to 43,121.

MAIN FEATURES *continued*

Following the division of the City of Wanneroo (which had 219,932 residents at 30 June 1997), Stirling became the most populous Local Government Area with 175,569 residents. This was followed by the Cities of Joondalup with 154,641 residents and Melville with 95,854 residents.

REST OF THE STATE

Between 30 June 1997 and 30 June 1998 the Estimated Resident Population of the Rest of the State increased by 10,396 to 489,485, an increase of 2.2%.

The South West Statistical Division continued as the most populous statistical division outside Perth, growing from 172,096 to 177,801, an increase of 5,705 persons (3.3%).

Most Statistical Local Areas in the South West Statistical Division increased in population, the exceptions being Bridgetown-Greenbushes, Boyup Brook, and Collie which recorded small losses. Mandurah, the most populous Statistical Local Area with 43,489 residents, continued to grow, increasing by 1,423 persons (3.4%) in 1997-98. Strong growth also continued in the Busselton and Augusta-Margaret River area and in the Shires of Harvey and Dardanup, adjoining the regional centre of Bunbury.

The Kimberley Statistical Division had the highest percentage growth (4.6%). Growth occurred in all Statistical Local Areas, with Halls Creek increasing by 8.3% (257 persons), Derby-West Kimberley by 6.4% (424 persons), Broome by 3.2% (330 persons) and Wyndham-East Kimberley by 3.0% (200 persons).

Several Statistical Local Areas in Lower Great Southern recorded small decreases in population, but increases in the City of Albany (Central and Balance) and the adjoining Shire of Denmark, countered these to give a net increase of 669 persons (1.3%).

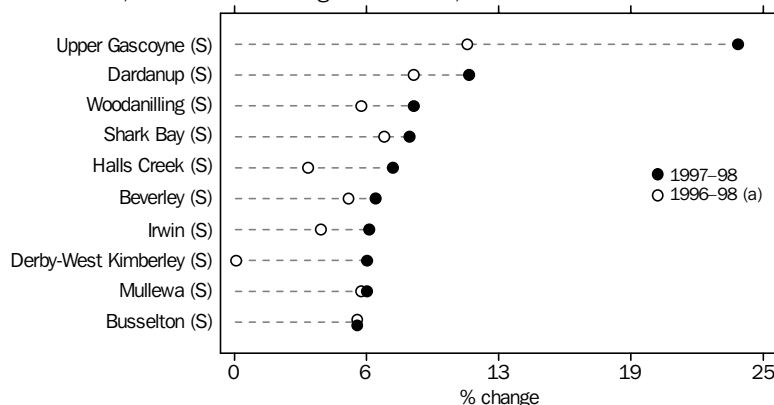
Following a population loss in the previous year, Upper Great Southern Statistical Division experienced a small net increase (0.6%) in 1997-98. This was largely due to growth in the Town and Shire of Narrogin and the Shire of Brookton, which experienced population increases of 99, 37 and 26 persons, respectively. Most of the remaining Statistical Local Areas in Upper Great Southern had small decreases in population.

About half (13 of 29) of the Statistical Local Areas in the Midlands Statistical Division continued to lose population. However, substantial population increases, mainly in the Shires of Dandaragan, Gingin, Beverley and Northam and the Town of Northam, resulted in the population of the Statistical Division increasing by 604 persons (1.2%).

MAIN FEATURES *continued*

In the South Eastern Statistical Division population increases of 908 persons in Kalgoorlie/Boulder and 310 persons in Esperance were partially offset by losses of 269 in Coolgardie, 94 in Leonora, 33 in Dundas and 28 in Laverton. In the Statistical Division as a whole, the net increase was 835 persons (1.5%).

POPULATION, Rate of Growth — High Growth SLAs, Other than Perth



In the Central Statistical Division, the total population increased by 705 persons (1.2%) although some Statistical Local Areas experienced a fall in population. Most growth occurred in the Shire of Greenough (354 persons) and the adjacent Shire of Irwin (176 persons). Upper Gascoyne, Shark Bay, Coorow and Mullewa also experienced significant growth. The main population losses occurred in Carnavon, Cue and Mount Magnet.

The population of Pilbara Statistical Division increased by 554 people (1.3%) in 1997-98. Port Hedland and Roebourne recorded increases of 465 persons (3.6%) and 452 persons (3.2%), respectively. However, in the Fortescue Statistical Subdivision a loss of 443 persons in the Shire of Ashburton almost balanced the gain in Roebourne.

AGE AND SEX

There were 921,613 males and 909,786 females in Western Australia at 30 June 1998.

Males continued to outnumber females in all Statistical Divisions except Perth where there were 8,440 more females. The proportion of males in the population varied across Statistical Divisions ranging from 49.7% in Perth to 55.3% in the Pilbara.

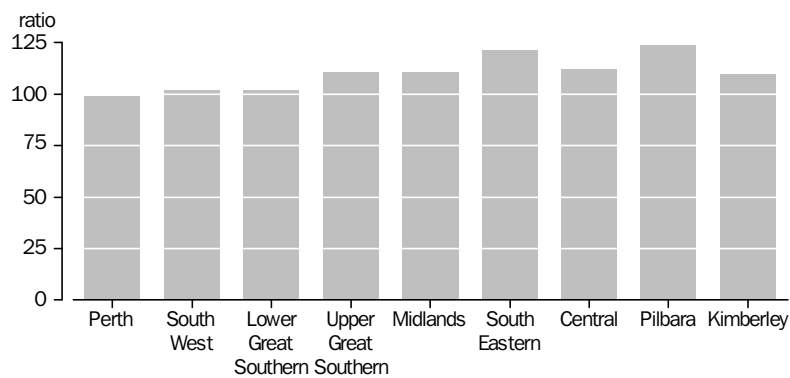
Females outnumbered males in all age groups over 64 years of age and constituted 55.6% of the population aged 65 years and over.

At 30 June 1998 there were 1,242,847 persons of working age (15-64 years) in Western Australia, of whom 921,920 resided in the Perth Statistical Division. Males accounted for 50.9% of the population of working age.

Persons in the "dependant" age groups (0-14 years and 65 years and over) amounted to 32.1% of the Western Australian population. These comprised 396,601 persons aged between 0 and 14 years and 191,951 persons aged 65 years and over.

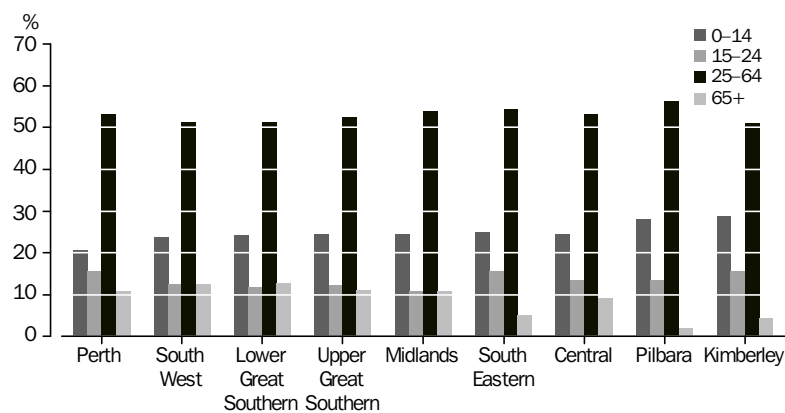
MAIN FEATURES *continued*

SEX RATIO, Statistical Divisions



The Pilbara and Kimberley Statistical Divisions had the greatest proportion of persons in the younger "dependant" age group, with 27.9% and 28.9% respectively. They also had the lowest proportion of persons in the older "dependant" age group, with 2.0% and 4.4% respectively. These areas, particularly the Kimberley, have higher proportions of Indigenous persons who have a higher fertility rate and lower life expectancy than non-Indigenous persons. The presence of remote mining operations also contributes to the "younger person" profile of these areas, increasing the proportion of working age adults relative to older persons.

AGE STRUCTURE, Statistical Divisions



The South West and Lower Great Southern Statistical Divisions had the greatest proportion of persons in the older "dependant" age group, with 12.5% and 12.7% respectively. The Statistical Local Areas of Albany – Central, Mandurah and Busselton continued to have concentrations of persons in the older "dependant" age group, with 17.8%, 16.6% and 14.7% of persons respectively aged 65 years and over.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

INTRODUCTION

1 This publication presents the estimates of the resident population of Western Australia by age and sex at 30 June 1998. Data have been compiled for Statistical Divisions, Subdivisions and Statistical Local Areas (SLAs). Estimates of SLA populations at 30 June 1996 and 30 June 1997 are included for comparison.

METHODOLOGY

2 The estimated resident population (ERP) is the official population estimates series compiled according to the place of usual residence of the population. An explanation of the conceptual basis is given in the ABS Information Paper entitled *Population Estimates: Concepts, Sources and Methods* (Catalogue Number 3228.0) issued on 23 June 1995.

3 The estimated resident population as at 30 June 1996 for each SLA is based on usual residence census counts, adjusted for census underenumeration and the number of residents temporarily overseas at the census date.

4 For intercensal years (i.e. 1997 and 1998), the estimated resident population at 30 June for each SLA is calculated using a linear regression model. In this method a mathematical relationship is established between changes in population and changes in other variables, known as predictor variables, over the period between the two most recent censuses for which detailed information is available (i.e. 1991 and 1996). This relationship is then used to estimate the change in population of each area since the date of the last census (i.e. 1996), based on the changes in the predictor variables since that date. The predictor variables in the current model are private dwellings and medicare enrolment data.

5 Other relevant information is also used to supplement the estimates from the regression model when preparing the published estimates. This includes information on significant local factors which might have caused population changes during the relevant period.

AREA STATISTICS

6 ABS area statistics are classified according to the *Australian Standard Geographical Classification, 1998 Edition* (Catalogue Number 1216.0). Figures previously published for local government areas, statistical subdivisions and divisions are directly comparable with this classification. The Cities of Perth, Fremantle, Joondalup, Stirling and Albany and the Shire of Wanneroo comprise a number of SLAs.

7 SLAs are marked (C) for City, (T) for Town or (S) for Shire. The names and designations are as they existed at 1 July 1998.

BOUNDARY AND NAME CHANGES

8 From 1 July 1998, the City of Wanneroo became two separate local government areas, the Shire of Wanneroo and the City of Joondalup; the Town and Shire of Albany were merged to form the City of Albany; and the locality of Maylands was transferred from the City of Stirling to the City of Bayswater. The estimated resident population for each of the new local government areas has been calculated for the years 1991 to 1997.

REVISIONS

9 The estimates for 30 June 1996 contained in this publication are final figures. The estimates for 30 June 1997 and 30 June 1998 are preliminary and subject to revision.

RELIABILITY

10 Although estimates are calculated and presented to the nearest whole number, accuracy to this level is not claimed and should not be assumed
