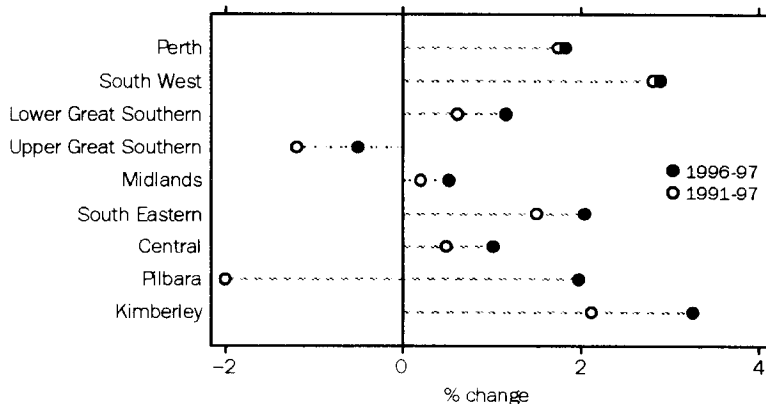
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SUMMARY

The Estimated Resident Population of Western Australia at 30 June 1997 was 1,798,129. This was an increase of 32,873 persons or 1.86% from 30 June 1996.

The proportion of the State population residing in the Perth Statistical Division was 73.4% at 30 June 1997, the same as it was in 1996. This figure has risen slowly from 68.2% in 1971 and 72.7% at 30 June 1991.

POPULATION, Average Annual Growth—Statistical Divisions



The South West Statistical Division has the second highest Estimated Resident Population after the Perth Statistical Division, followed by the Central and the South Eastern Statistical Divisions.

The South West Statistical Division continued to grow strongly, increasing by 4,847 persons (2.90%). In percentage terms, this was exceeded only by Kimberley Statistical Division which grew by 3.26% (838 persons).

Pilbara Statistical Division increased by 1.98% following a fall of 13.16% over the five year period, 30 June 1991 to 30 June 1996.

Upper Great Southern was the only Statistical Division recording a population decrease, declining by 100 persons (0.50%).

PERTH STATISTICAL DIVISION

Between 30 June 1996 and 30 June 1997 the Estimated Resident Population of the Perth Statistical Division increased by 23,882 persons to 1,318,974 - an increase of 1.84%. This is a slight increase on the average annual growth rate since 30 June 1991 of 1.75%.

The Estimated Resident Population for all Statistical Local Areas in Perth Statistical Division increased during 1996-97. These ranged from an increase of 0.01% (6 persons) in Bayswater to 11.37% (2,029 persons) in Wanneroo - North-West.

The largest increases were 3,044 persons in Swan (4.26%) and 2,991 persons in Rockingham (4.85%).

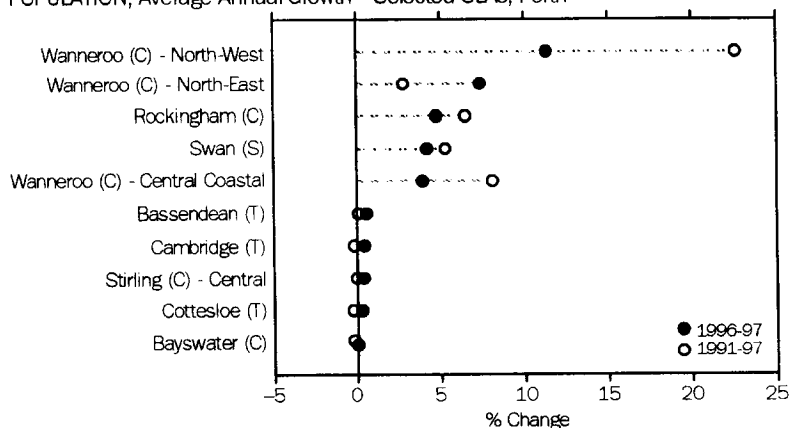
Growth continues to be strongest in Statistical Local Areas along the main "population corridors", particularly in the Statistical Local Areas which constitute Wanneroo (C) in the north west of Perth Statistical Division, Swan in the north east, Canning and Gosnells in the south east and Rockingham and Cockburn in the south west.

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MAIN FEATURES *continued*

The City of Wanneroo, with 219,964 residents, is the most populous Local Government Area in Western Australia, followed by the City of Stirling (183,894 residents) and the City of Melville (94,671 residents).

REST OF THE STATE

Between 30 June 1996 and 30 June 1997 the Estimated Resident Population of the Rest of the State increased by 8,991 to 479,155, an increase of 1.91%.

The South West Statistical Division continues to remain the dominant statistical division outside the Perth Statistical Division, growing from 167,274 to 172,121, an increase of 4,847 persons (2.90%).

Most Statistical Local Areas in the South West Statistical Division had increases in population, the exceptions being Boyup Brook and Collie which recorded small losses. Mandurah, the most populous Statistical Local Area with 42,072 residents, continues to grow strongly, increasing by 1,612 people (3.98%) in 1996-97. Most other growth was in the Busselton and Augusta-Margaret River area and in the Shires of Harvey, Dardanup and Capel, which surround the regional centre of Bunbury.

The Kimberley Statistical Division had the highest percentage growth (3.26%). Most growth, 409 persons (4.19%), was in Broome, followed by Halls Creek which increased by 173 persons (5.95%).

Most Statistical Local Areas in Lower Great Southern recorded small decreases in population, but increases in the Town and Shire of Albany and the adjoining Shires of Denmark and Plantagenet countered these to give a net increase of 583 persons (1.16%).

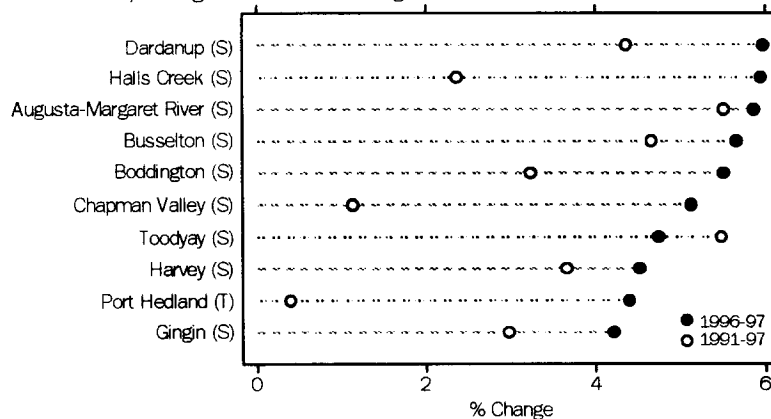
Upper Great Southern was the only Statistical Division to have a loss of population. Most Statistical Local Areas experienced small decreases in population. The exceptions were the Town of Narrogin and the Shire of Wickepin which had increases of 44 and 10 persons respectively.

In the Midlands Statistical Division, 16 of 29 Statistical Local Areas recorded population decreases. However, population increases, mainly in the Shire of Dandaragan and the Shires of Gingin, Toodyay and York, which adjoin the Perth Statistical Division, resulted in the population of the Statistical Division increasing by 270 persons (0.52%).

MAIN FEATURES *continued*

In the South Eastern Statistical Division population increases of 901 persons (3.05%) in Kalgoorlie / Boulder and 223 persons (1.81%) in Esperance made up most of the total increase of 1,154 persons in the Division. Small increases in other Shires did little more than balance the losses of 49 and 53 persons from the Shires of Coolgardie and Dundas respectively.

Most growth in the Central Statistical Division was in Geraldton (95 persons) and the adjacent Shires of Greenough (357 persons), Irwin (105 persons), Northampton (53 persons) and Chapman Valley (43 persons). Other Shires showing growth were mainly those which border the coast.

The population of Pilbara Statistical Division increased by 799 people (1.98%) in 1996-97. This compares with average annual losses of 2.00% during the period 1991 to 1997. Most growth was in Port Hedland which increased by 542 persons (4.41%).

AGE AND SEX

There were 904,409 males and 893,720 females in Western Australia at 30 June 1997.

Males outnumber females in all Statistical Divisions except Perth where there were 9,678 more females.

The percentages of males in the population varied considerably across the Statistical Divisions ranging from 49.63% in Perth to 54.79% and 55.30% in South-Eastern and Pilbara Statistical Divisions respectively.

Females outnumbered males in all age groups over 64 years and make up 55.63% of the population aged 65 years and over.

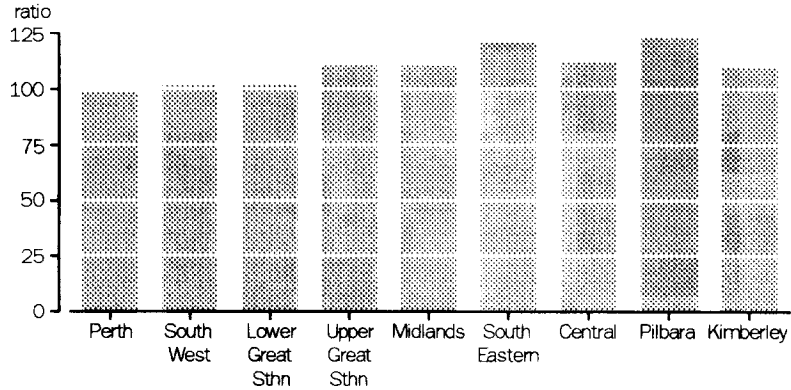
The median age of Western Australia's population has gradually increased from 30.1 years in 1986 to 33.1 in 1996 and to 33.3 years as at 30 June 1997. The median age of males at 30 June 1997 was 32.7 years and 33.9 years for females.

As at 30 June 1997 there were 1,215,109 persons of working age (15 - 64 years) in Western Australia, 902,007 of whom resided in the Perth Statistical Division. Males accounted for 50.86% of the working age population.

MAIN FEATURES *continued*

There were 583,020 persons in the "dependant" age groups (0 - 14 years and 65 years and over) in Western Australia, comprising 395,017 aged between 0 and 14 years and 188,003 aged 65 and over.

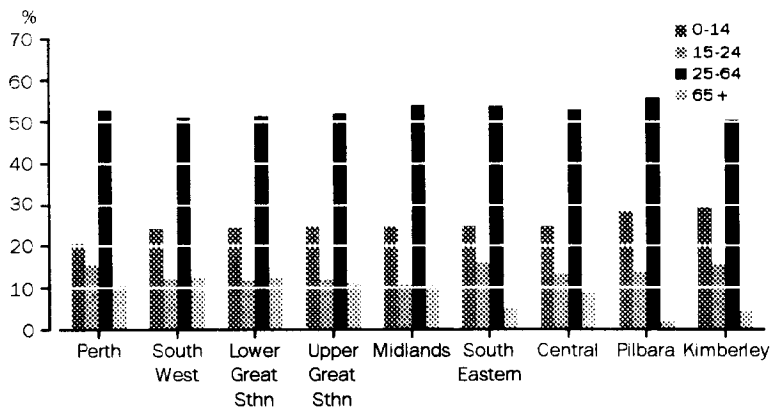
SEX RATIO, Statistical Divisions

The Pilbara and Kimberley Statistical Divisions have the greatest proportion of persons in the younger "dependant" age group, with 28.33% and 29.26%, respectively. They also have the lowest proportion of persons in the older "dependant" age group, with 1.95% and 4.45%, respectively. These areas, particularly the Kimberley Statistical Division, have higher proportions of Indigenous persons who have a higher fertility rate and lower life expectancy than non-Indigenous persons. The presence of remote mining operations also contributes to the "younger person" profile of these areas, increasing the proportion of working age adults relative to older persons.

AGE STRUCTURE, Statistical Divisions—30 June 1997



The South West and Lower Great Southern Statistical Divisions have the greatest proportion of persons in the older "dependant" age group, with 12.52% and 12.44%, respectively. There are concentrations of persons in the older "dependant" age group in Albany (Town), Mandurah and Busselton where 17.84%, 16.55% and 15.03% of persons are aged 65 years and over.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

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INTRODUCTION

1 This publication presents the estimates of the resident population of Western Australia by age and sex at 30 June 1997. Data have been compiled for Statistical Divisions, Subdivisions and Statistical Local Areas (SLAs). Estimates of SLA populations at 30 June 1991 and 30 June 1996 are included for comparison.

METHODOLOGY

2 The estimated resident population (ERP) is the official population estimates series compiled according to the place of usual residence of the population. An explanation of the conceptual basis is given in the ABS Information Paper entitled *Population Estimates: Concepts, Sources and Methods* (Catalogue Number 3228.0) issued on 23 June 1995.

3 The estimated resident population as at 30 June 1991 and 30 June 1996 for each SLA is based on usual residence census counts, adjusted for census underenumeration and the number of residents temporarily overseas at the census date.

4 For intercensal years, the estimated resident population at 30 June 1997 for each SLA is calculated using a linear regression model. In this method a mathematical relationship is established between changes in population and changes in other variables, known as predictor variables, over the period between the two most recent censuses for which detailed information is available (i.e. 1991 and 1996). This relationship is then used to estimate the change in population of each area since the date of the last census (i.e. 1996), based on the changes in the predictor variables since that date. The predictor variables in the current model are private dwellings and medicare enrolment data.

5 Other relevant information is also used to supplement the estimates from the regression model when preparing the published estimates. This includes information on significant local factors which might have caused population changes during the relevant period.

AREA STATISTICS

6 ABS area statistics are classified according to the *Australian Standard Geographical Classification, 1996 Edition* (Catalogue Number 1216.0). Figures previously published for local government areas, statistical sub-divisions and divisions are directly comparable with this classification. The Cities of Perth, Fremantle, Stirling and Wanneroo comprise a number of SLAs. However, estimates for individual SLAs were not compiled for these areas prior to 1986.

7 SLAs are marked (C) for City, (T) for Town or (S) for Shire. The names and designations are as they existed at 30 June 1997.

REVISIONS

8 The estimates for 30 June 1991 and 30 June 1996 contained in this publication are final figures. The estimates for 30 June 1997 are preliminary and subject to revision.

RELIABILITY

9 Although estimates are calculated and presented to the nearest whole number, accuracy to this level is not claimed and should not be assumed.

There are also estimates available by census collection districts (CDs) and SLAs based on the 1991 census boundaries. Prices start from \$100 for 1 year and depend on the level of detail requested.

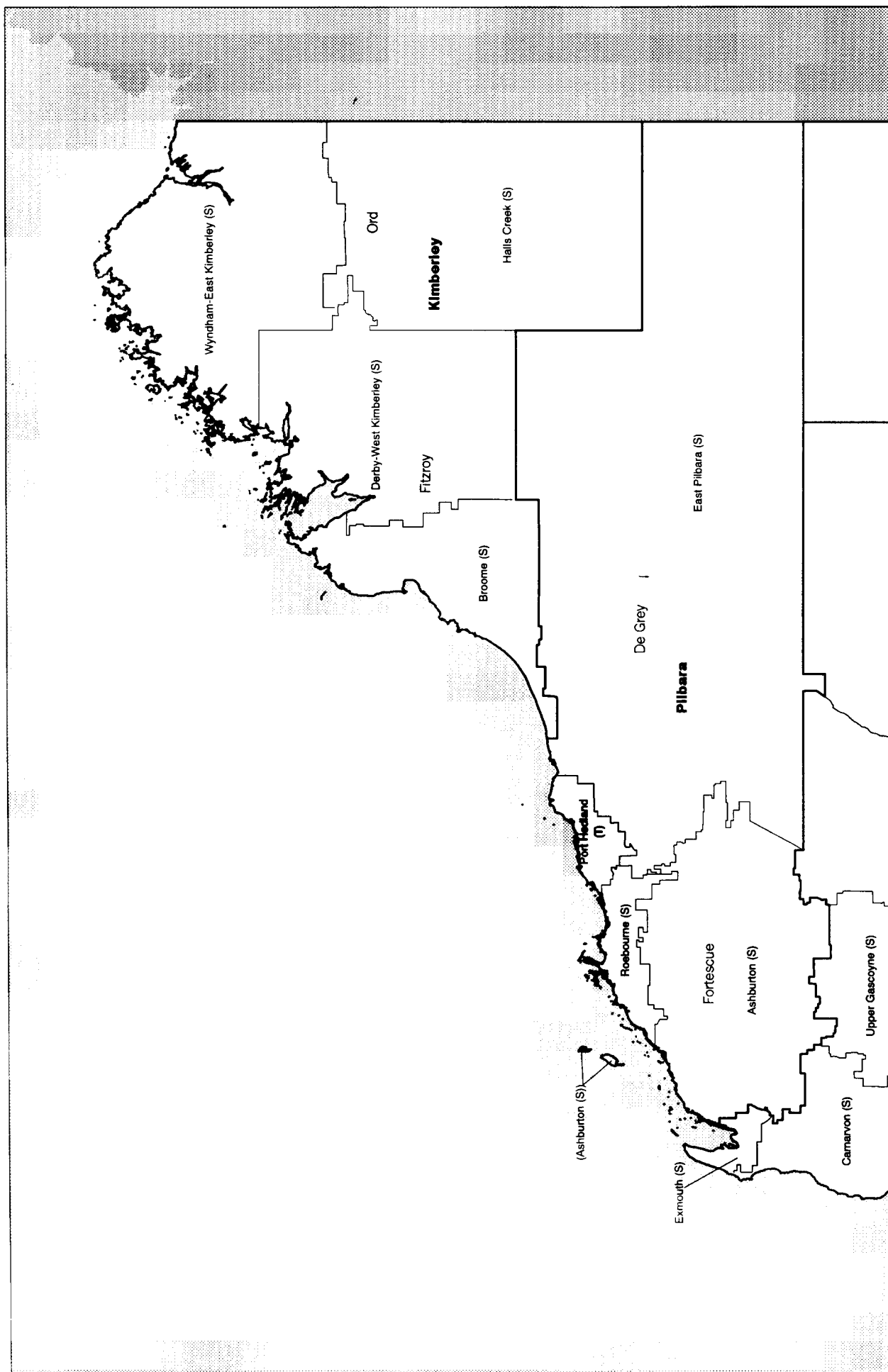
13 Population projections data at the CD, SLA or postcode level are available on a standard or customised basis. Standard projections are by sex and 5-year age groups and project to the year 2012. Prices commence at \$100 per SLA or postcode based region with discounts for multiple regions. Customised projections can project to the year 2041 and prices range from \$300 to \$500 per region, depending on the level of detail requested. Discounts also apply for multiple regions.

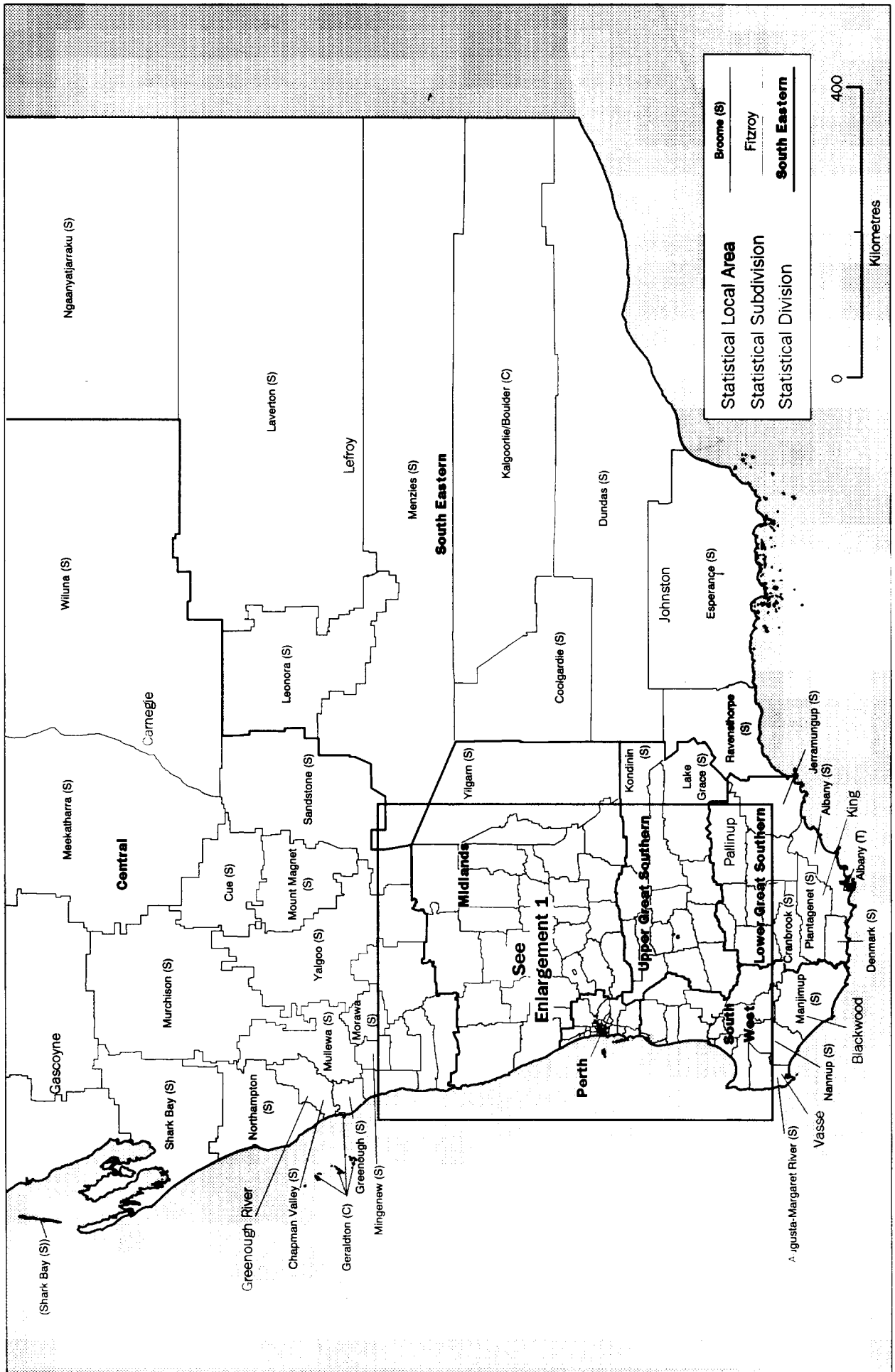

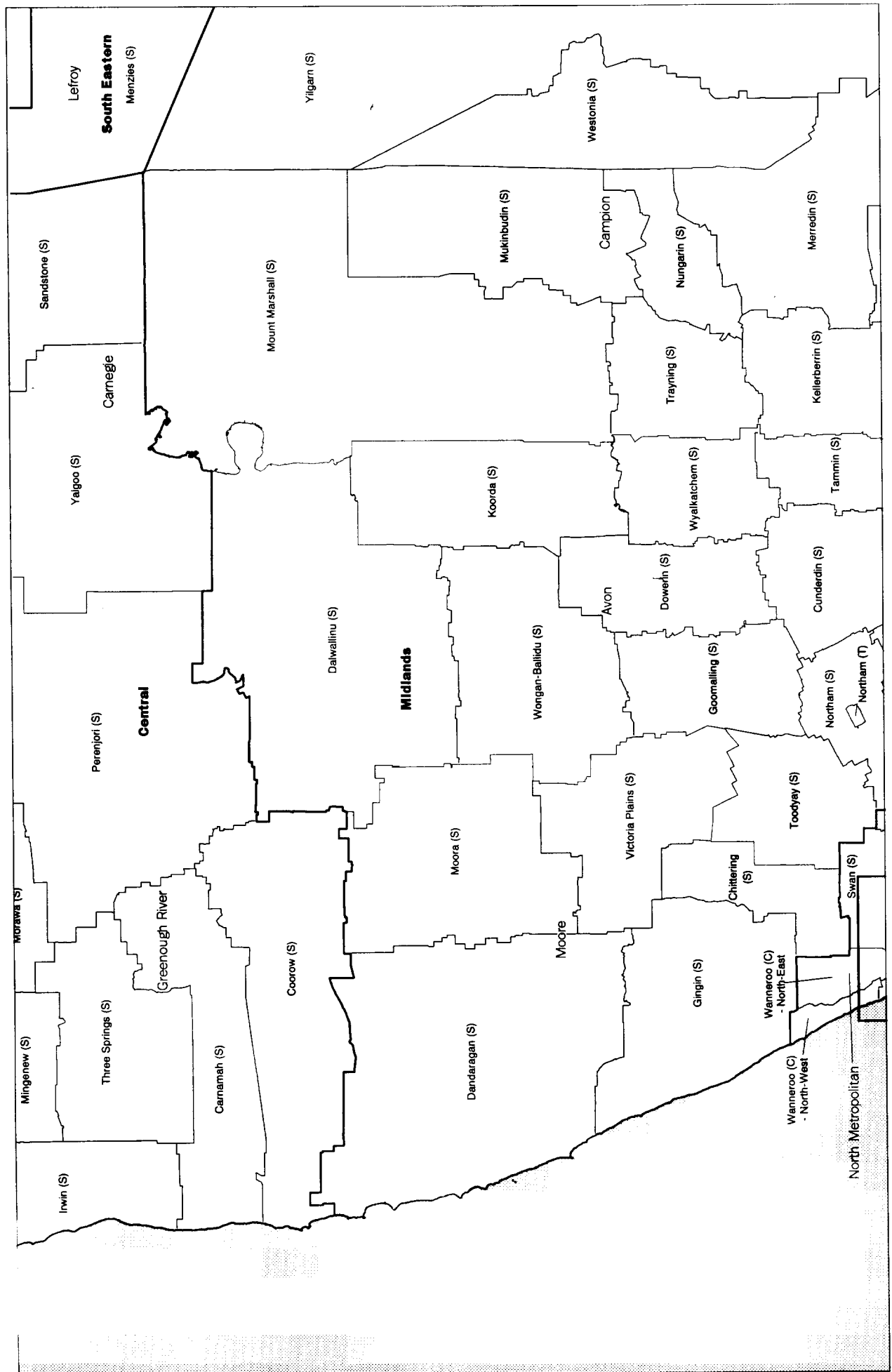

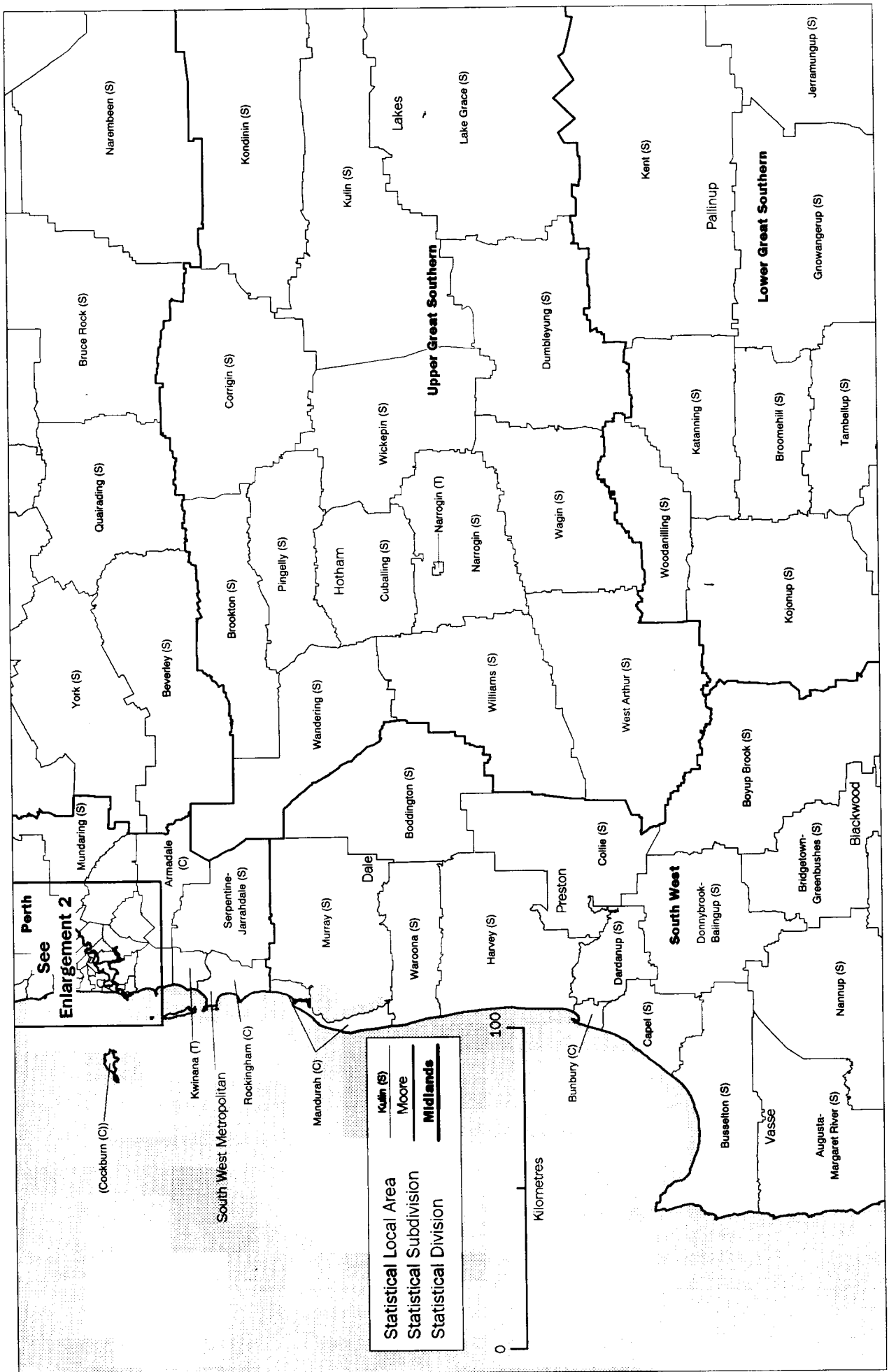
