POPULATION CHANGE

NATIONAL

Between 30 June 1996 and the 30 June 1997 Australia's estimated resident population grew by 1.2% (221,500 people). This growth rate is marginally lower than the average annual growth rate of 1.1% since 30 June 1992.

STATE

Tasmania was the only State or Territory to record a loss of population between 30 June 1996 and 30 June 1997 (940 people). Of the other States and Territories, New South Wales recorded the highest increase in population of 69,600 people over the year followed by Queensland (62,500 people), Victoria (45,000 people), and Western Australia (32,900 people).

The Northern Territory experienced the highest annual growth rate between 30 June 1996 and the 30 June 1997 of 2.9%, well above the rate for Australia as a whole (1.2%). Queensland (1.9%) and Western Australia (1.9%) also experienced annual growth rates higher than that of Australia. New South Wales (1.1%), Victoria (1.0%), South Australia (0.4%) and the Australian Capital Territory (0.5%) grew more slowly than the national average.

Since 30 June 1992, Queensland had the largest increase in population (371,300 people), as well as the highest average annual growth rate (2.3%). New South Wales recorded the second largest increase in population (311,800 people) followed by Victoria (150,100 people) and Western Australia (140,100 people). The Northern Territory had the second highest average annual growth rate of 2.2% followed by Western Australia (1.6%).

CAPITAL CITY/BALANCE OF STATE

Over two thirds of Australia's population growth (151,500) occurred in capital city Statistical Divisions (SDs). Between 30 June 1996 and 30 June 1997, Sydney recorded the largest increase of all the capital cities (53,600 people) while Darwin grew the most rapidly (2.5%). Hobart was the only capital city to decline in population (250 people or -0.1%).

In most States and Territories the balance of State grew more slowly than the capital city SD, with the exception of the Northern Territory. While the population of Darwin increased by 2,000 people (2.5%) between 30 June 1996 and 30 June 1997, the population of the balance of the Northern Territory increased by 3,300 people (3.3%).

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

LARGEST POPULATION CHANGES

POPULATION INCREASES

Of the top twenty Local Government Areas (LGAs) with the largest increases in population in the year ending 30 June 1997, seven were in Queensland, six in New South Wales, four in Victoria and three in Western Australia.

Brisbane (C) was the LGA with the largest increase in population between 30 June 1996 and 30 June 1997, increasing by 14,000 people or 1.7%. The second largest population growth occurred in the Gold Coast (C) which grew by 13,100 people or 3.7%. However, over the five years, 92–97, the Gold Coast has experienced greater increases in population than Brisbane both in numbers and rate, with an average annual growth rate of 4.6%, compared to 1.5%. Of the seven most growing LGAs in Queensland, only Cairns (C) is not in the south-east corner of Queensland.

Wanneroo in the northern metropolitan area of Perth, experienced the third largest population growth, increasing by 6,600 people or 3.1%. Swan (S), also in north in Perth, and Rockingham (C) in south-western Perth also experienced large population increases.

Sydney experienced large growth; Liverpool (C) and Blacktown (C) in the west, Wyong (A) and Gosford (C) in the outer north, and Sutherland Shire (A) in the south. South Sydney was the only inner city LGA to grow.

The largest growth in Victoria occurred in the Melbourne LGAs of Casey (C) in the south east, Hume (C) in the north and Melton (S) in the west.

POPULATION DECLINES

In the year ending 30 June 1997, declines in population were not of the same magnitude as increases. Most LGAs that experienced population losses were located outside metropolitan areas and several were in mining and manufacturing communities.

In New South Wales, all four LGAs with the largest declines were outside Sydney, with Broken Hill (C) and Tamworth (C) showing the largest decline (340 people). While no Melbourne LGAs ranked among those with the largest losses at 30 June 1997, three largely rural areas did. Conversely, prior to 1997 almost half the metropolitan LGAs with large declines in population were located in Melbourne.

South Australia had four of the twenty LGAs with the largest population losses. Elizabeth (C) in north Adelaide recorded the fourth largest loss of any LGA, closely followed by Port Augusta (C). Seven of the twenty LGAs were in Tasmania such as Launceston (C) in the north, with the third largest loss, and West Coast (M) in the west with the fifth.


LARGEST INCREASES IN POPULATION

Between 30 June 1996 and 30 June 1997, nineteen of the twenty Statistical Local Areas (SLAs) that recorded the largest increases in population were located in Sydney (10), Melbourne (5) and Perth (4).

In New South Wales the majority of population growth occurred in the east of the State, in particular along the coast and near the northern border of the Australian Capital Territory. In Sydney the greatest increases occurred to the west in Liverpool (C), Blacktown (C) and Penrith (C), and Sutherland Shire (A) and South Sydney (C) in the South. Wyong (A) and Gosford (C) in northern Sydney also grew. Lake Macquarie, in New South Wales' Hunter region, was the only SLA not within a capital city in the top twenty growing SLAs. The largest population growth in Western Australia occurred in the outer areas of Perth. The largest increases were in Swan (S) in the north, Rockingham (C) in the south west, Wanneroo (G) - North-West in the north and Gosnells (C) in the south-east. Likewise, most of Victoria's large growth areas were also on the outskirts of Melbourne. They included Melton (S) - East in the west and Casey (C) - Berwick in the east. Melbourne (C) - Remainder also grew. Most of Queensland's growth was concentrated on the east coast, mainly around large urban centres and in the new and outer suburbs of Brisbane.

The distribution of SLAs experiencing the highest percentage growth in the last year was quite different from the distribution of those SLAs exhibiting the largest numeric growth. Of the top twenty SLAs, thirteen were in Queensland with only four of those in Brisbane. Melton (S) - East (56.0%) in outer west Melbourne experienced the highest percentage growth followed by Ngunnawal in Canberra (21.4%).

INDIVIDUAL STATISTICAL LOCAL AREAS WITH INCREASING POPULATION

NEW SOUTH WALES

Liverpool (C)

Between 30 June 1996 and 30 June 1997, Liverpool in Sydney's western suburbs recorded the largest increase in the estimated resident population of all SLAs in Australia. The population of Liverpool increased by 6,200 people (5.0%) over the year. Since 1992, Liverpool has increased by 25,900 people (24.8%) with an average annual increase of 4.5%.

Blacktown (C)

Blacktown in Sydney's north-west experienced the second largest growth in population of all SLAs between 1996 and 1997, increasing by 4,400 people. Despite recording the second largest increase in population, the base population of this SLA is quite large which resulted in a percentage increase of only 1.8%. Since 1992, the population of this SLA has grown by 20,200 people, averaging a growth of 1.7% each year.

Lake Macquarie (C)

Lake Macquarie (C), in the Hunter SD of New South Wales, was the only SLA not within a capital city to appear in the top twenty fastest growing SLAs. The population of this SLA grew by 2,200 people between 1996 and 1997 and has grown by 7,600 people since 1992.

VICTORIA

Casey (C) - Berwick

Casey (C) - Berwick in Melbourne's outer south-east, experienced the highest growth of all Victorian SLAs. The estimated resident population grew by 2,900 people between 1996 and 1997.

The largest growth in this SLA occurred during the first half of the 1990s. In 1992 the population was 30,900, by 1996 it had increased 14,700 to 45,600. The average annual growth rate since 1992 was 9.4% per year, while the growth rate for 1996-97 was 6.4%.

QUEENSLAND

Doolandella-Forest Lake

Queensland tends to have smaller SLAs than most other States. Therefore Queensland has no SLAs that experienced very large numeric increases between 30 June 1996 and 30 June 1997 but several with high growth rates. Doolandella-Forest Lake in Brisbane's outer west recorded the third highest percentage increase (21%) of all SLAs. In 1992 the population was only 570 people by 1997 it had increased to 7,900 people, with an average annual growth rate of 69.2%.

STATISTICAL LOCAL AREAS *continued*

WESTERN AUSTRALIA

Swan (S)

Swan (S) in east Perth recorded the largest growth in Western Australia and the third largest in all of Australia. Its population increased from 57,300 in 1992 to 74,600 in 1997, an average annual increase of 5.4%.

Rockingham (C)

Rockingham (C), located in the south-west of Perth, experienced the second largest increase in population in Western Australia and the fourth largest increase in Australia. This SLA increased by 3,000 people in 1996-97 and by 17,700 people since 30 June 1992, with an average annual growth rate of 6.6%.

AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY

Ngunnawal

Ngunnawal is one of the new suburbs in north Canberra. In 1992 no one lived in this SLA, by 1996 there were 4,500 people resident there and by 1997 it had grown to 5,500 people. Ngunnawal experienced the second highest growth rate in Australia for the period (21.4%).

STATISTICAL LOCAL AREAS *continued*

LARGEST DECLINES IN POPULATION

Declines in population occurring in an SLA were not of the same magnitude as increases.

Between 30 June 1996 and 30 June 1997, all of the top twenty SLAs exhibiting the largest declines in population were located in east and south Australia; six in Tasmania, four in both New South Wales and South Australia, three in Victoria, two in Queensland and one in the Australian Capital Territory. Of the top twenty declining SLAs, thirteen were located outside of a capital city.

In New South Wales, the rural areas in the west and north experienced most population loss. Broken Hill (C) in the west and Tamworth (C) and Narrabri (A) in the north experienced relatively large population losses. Most of Victoria's population losses occurred in the rural regions in the west and east of the State. However Victoria's largest decline occurred in Melbourne in Monash (C) - Waverley East. Except for the outer suburbs of Adelaide and regions near the coast, most of South Australia's SLAs experienced marginal declines. Elizabeth (C) north of Adelaide experienced the third largest decline in population. Declines occurred in most regions of Tasmania, in particular the west, north-west, north-east and central areas of the State. Launceston (C) - Part B experienced the fourth largest decline in Australia and the largest decline in Tasmania.

SLAs experiencing high percentage declines in population were found in all of the States and Territories except Western Australia and the Northern Territory. Seven of the top twenty were located in New South Wales and five in Victoria. Only three of the SLAs that experienced high percentage declines were located in a metropolitan area — Wanniassa and Evatt in Canberra and Elizabeth in Adelaide.

INDIVIDUAL STATISTICAL LOCAL AREAS WITH DECLINING POPULATION

NEW SOUTH WALES

Broken Hill (C)

Between 30 June 1996 and 30 June 1997, Broken Hill (C), located in western New South Wales, recorded the largest population loss of all the SLAs in Australia. The population at 30 June 1997 was 21,600, 340 people less than at 30 June 1996 and 2,400 less than at 30 June 1992. This represents a loss of 1.6% of the population during 1996–97 and an average annual loss of 2.1% over the past five years.

Tamworth

Situated in northern New South Wales, Tamworth (C) experienced the second largest population loss of any SLA in Australia. The population of this SLA declined by 340 people between 1996 and 1997, from 35,600 to 35,200. After a small increase between 1992 and 1993 the population of Tamworth has been steadily declining since.

VICTORIA

Monash (C) - Waverley East

Monash (C) - Waverley East recorded the largest population loss in Victoria and the fifth in Australia, decreasing by 280 people. Situated in eastern middle Melbourne, this SLA was one of only two SLAs in Melbourne to decrease in population between 1996 and 1997, the other being Frankston (C) - West. Monash (C) has declined an average of 1.1% each year since 1992.

QUEENSLAND

Mount Isa (C)

The population of Mount Isa (C), in Queensland's north-west, declined by 160 people between 1996 and 1997. Mount Isa (C) experienced the largest loss of population in Queensland.

SOUTH AUSTRALIA

Elizabeth (C)

Elizabeth (C), located in northern Adelaide, experienced the third largest population loss of all SLAs in Australia. In 1992 there were 28,900 people living in Elizabeth. By 1996 this had dropped to 26,400, falling further to reach 26,100 by 1997. The population of this SLA has been steadily declining during the 1990s with an average annual loss of 2.0% since 1992.

Port Augusta (C)

Port Augusta (C), located in the Flinders Ranges north of Adelaide, recorded the sixth largest population loss (260 people) in 1996–97 in Australia and the second largest decline in South Australia. Like many SLAs in South Australia, the population of Port Augusta (C) has been declining steadily since 1992 at a rate of 1.4% per year.

STATISTICAL LOCAL AREAS *continued*

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TASMANIA

Launceston (C) - Part B

Of the six SLAs in Tasmania to show substantial declines in population in 1996-97, Launceston (C) - Part B recorded the largest. This was the fourth largest population loss of any Australian SLA. This SLA declined by 290 people during this period, from 60,700 to 60,400. The population of this SLA has been slowly declining since 1992 (61,900), averaging a loss of 0.5% each year.

West Coast (M)

Between 1996 and 1997, West Coast (M) in Tasmania experienced the seventh largest decline in population of all Australian SLAs. West Coast (M) has a relatively small population. In 1996, there were 6,400 people living there and this fell to 6,100 in 1997. This SLA experienced the largest percentage decline (3.5%) in Australia in 1996-97.

NEW ZEALAND REGIONAL COMPARISONS

POPULATION GROWTH

New Zealand's resident population at 30 June 1997 totalled 3,740,900 people. The population growth rate for the year ending 30 June 1997 was 1.3%, compared to an increase of 1.6% for the previous year. This was 0.1% higher than the population growth rate recorded for Australia at 30 June 1997 (1.2%).

The Auckland region is the largest and fastest growing region, with a population of 1,138,300 people at 30 June 1997, 29,100 or 2.6% higher than at 30 June 1996. Auckland accounted for just over 30% of the New Zealand resident population.

The Bay of Plenty Region, with a population growth rate of 2.0%, was the only other region that showed growth higher than the national average of 1.3%. Four regions experienced estimated falls in their populations, Manawatu-Wanganui (-0.2%), West Coast (-0.3%), Taranaki (-0.7%) and Southland (-1.2%).

At 30 June 1997, an estimated 1,904,400 (50.6%) people lived in just four main urban areas: Auckland, Hamilton, Wellington and Christchurch.

Nearly 70% of all New Zealand residents (2,623,300 people) were living in main urban areas at 30 June 1997, an increase of 39,200 (1.5%) over the 1996 level.

INTRODUCTION

- 1** This publication contains estimates of the resident population of the SLAs, SSDs, SDs, States, Territories and Australia and a selection of LGAs. The estimates for 1992 and 1996 are final and the estimates for 1997 are preliminary.
- 2** SLAs are ranked according to both numerical growth and growth rates between 1996 and 1997, allowing this publication to identify, in two ways, areas in Australia with the largest increases and declines in population.
- 3** SLAs with estimated resident population of less than 5,000 in 1997 (in total representing less than 10% of Australia's total population) are excluded from the percentage ranking.
- 4** Following the 1992 amendment to the Acts Interpretation Act to include the Indian Ocean Territories of Christmas Island and Cocos (Keeling) Islands as part of geographic Australia, population estimates at dates commencing from July 1993 include estimates for these two Territories. To reflect this change, another category of the State/Territory classification was created, known as Other Territories. Other Territories include Jervis Bay Territory as well as Christmas Island and the Cocos (Keeling) Islands. Data for Other Territories are included in tables where specifically noted. Prior to July 1993, Jervis Bay Territory was included in estimates for the Australian Capital Territory.

ROUNDED FIGURES

- 5** Population figures over 1,000 in the text of this publication are rounded to the nearest hundred, and figures less than 1,000 are rounded to the nearest ten. While unrounded figures are provided in tables, accuracy to the last digit is not claimed and should not be assumed. Because of inaccuracies in the data, ranking's of LGAs and SLAs are subject to minor errors.

ESTIMATED RESIDENT POPULATION

- 6** The estimated resident population of an area is the estimate of the number of persons who usually reside in that area irrespective of where they were on the date of the estimate.
- 7** The estimated resident populations contained in this publication are the official Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) population estimates. They are derived from 1996 Census population counts by making the following adjustments:
 - Census counts on a place of usual residence basis are obtained by counting each person in their stated SLA of usual residence, rather than where they were counted on census night. Persons who do not state their address of usual residence on the census form are proportionally allocated across all SLAs in the State or Territory. Overseas visitors are excluded from these counts.
 - These usual residence census counts are then adjusted for census undercount, by applying undercount rates derived from the 1996 Post Enumeration Survey. These rates take into account differences in undercount according to a person's age, sex and geographic location.

EXPLANATORY NOTES *continued*

ESTIMATED RESIDENT POPULATION *continued*

- Australian residents temporarily overseas on census night, excluded from census counts, are added back into the population. Estimates of Australians temporarily overseas on census night are obtained from passenger card data for persons returning to Australia in the year following the Census.
 - The above three adjustments result in the estimated resident population for each SLA as at census data, 6 August 1996. To obtain the estimated resident population as at 30 June 1996, the estimated increase in the population of each SLA due to natural increase and net migration between 30 June 1996 and 6 August 1996 is subtracted from the 6 August 1996 population estimates.
- 8** Although natural increase data are available for SLAs, the absence of reliable migration data for non-census years means that it is not possible to use the component method to update SLA population totals. Thus the 1992 and 1997 estimates in this publication have been produced using regression techniques.
- 9** A detailed explanation of the concept of estimated resident population, as adopted by the ABS for official population estimates, is contained in the ABS publication *Information Paper: Demographic Estimates — Concepts, Sources and Methods* (Cat. no. 3228.0).

STATISTICAL AREAS

- 10** This publication contains data presented according to the Australian Standard Geographical Classification 1996 Edition (ASGC). Under this classification, statistical areas are defined as follows:
- *Legal Local Government Areas (LGAs)*. These areas are the spatial units which represent the geographical areas of incorporated local government councils and incorporated Community Government Councils (CGCs) where the CGC is of sufficient size and statistical significance. The various types of LGAs are cities (C), areas (A), rural cities (RC), towns (T), shires (S), district councils (DC) and municipalities (M).
 - *Statistical Local Areas (SLAs)*. These geographical areas are, in most cases, identical with, or have been formed from a division of, whole LGAs. In other cases, they represent unincorporated areas. In aggregate, SLAs cover the whole of a State or Territory without gaps or overlaps. In some cases legal LGAs overlap statistical subdivision boundaries and therefore comprise two or three SLAs (Part A, Part B and, if necessary, Part C).
 - *Statistical Subdivision (SSDs)*. These are of intermediate size, between SLAs and SDs. In aggregate, they cover the whole of Australia without gaps or overlaps. They are defined as socially and economically homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable links between the inhabitants. In the non-urban areas an SSD is characterised by identifiable links between the economic units within the region, under the unifying influence of one or more major towns or cities.
 - *Statistical Divisions (SDs)*. These consist of one or more SSDs. The divisions are designed to be relatively homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable social and economic units within the region, under the unifying influence of one or more major towns or cities.

EXPLANATORY NOTES *continued*

12 For the purposes of this publication, all data refer to bounded areas as defined at 1 July 1996. The 1996 ASGC included LGA boundaries that were gazetted prior to 5 August 1995 (the census cut-off date) and SLA boundaries notified prior to 30 June 1996. Changes to LGA boundaries that have occurred between 5 August 1995 and 30 June 1997 are documented in the Appendix.

AVERAGE ANNUAL RATE OF GROWTH

14 The average annual rate of population growth, r , is calculated as a percentage using the formula:

$$r = \left[5 \sqrt{\frac{P_{97}}{P_{91}}} - 1 \right] \times 100$$

where P_{97} is the estimated resident population at 30 June 1992 and P_{96} is the estimated resident population at 30 June 1997.

15 Annual population estimates at 30 June for all SLAs in Australia are available electronically. This information can be customised to provide data for any choice of years from 1986 onwards and any combination of States and Territories.
